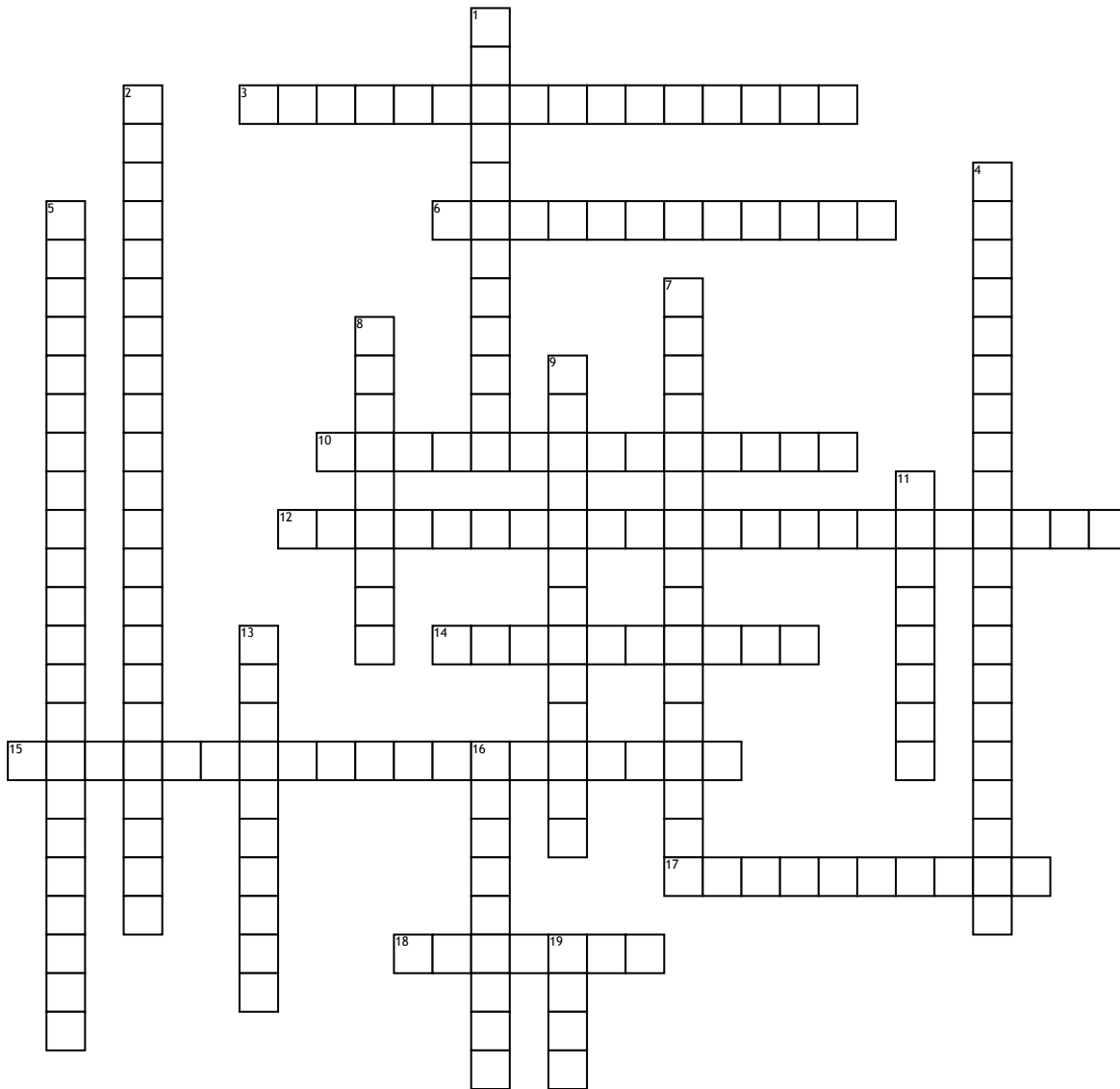


# Australian Crossword
