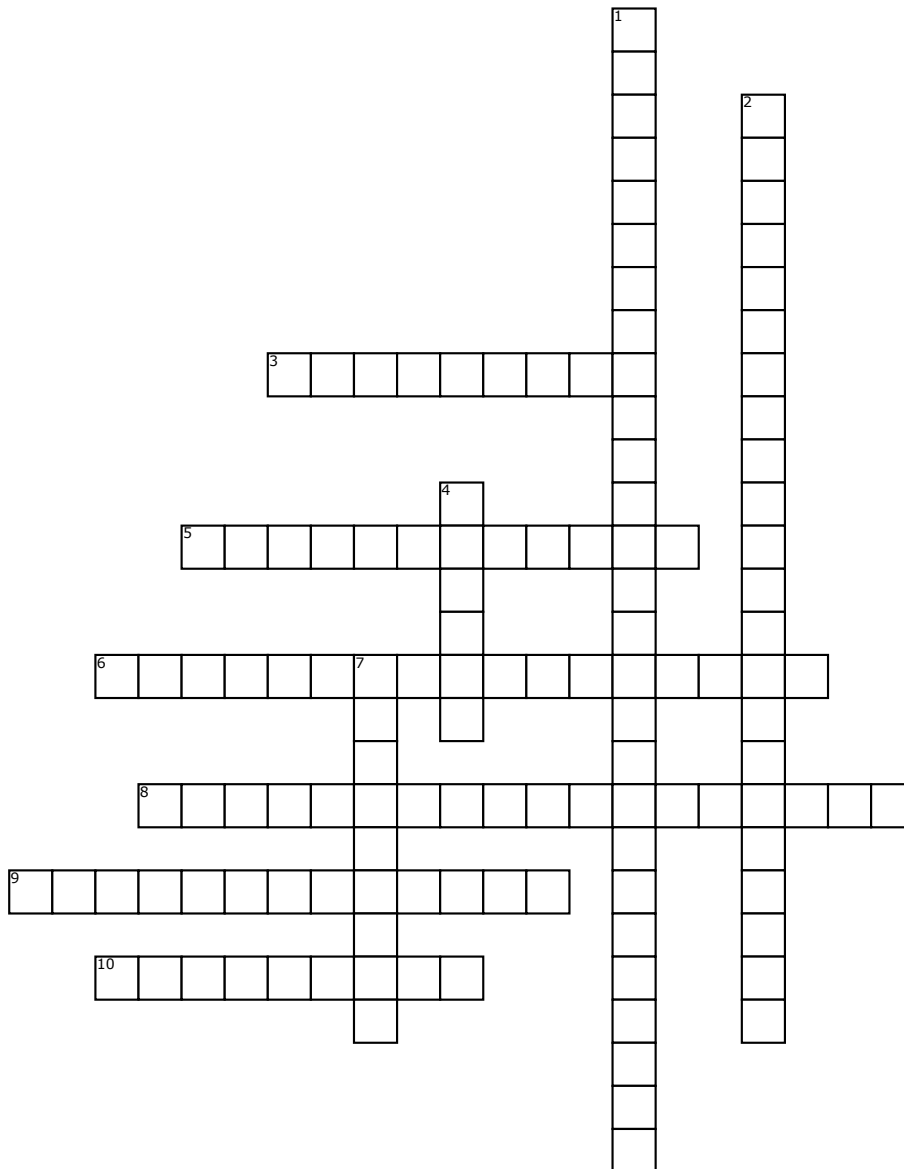


# Autism Spectrum Disorder
