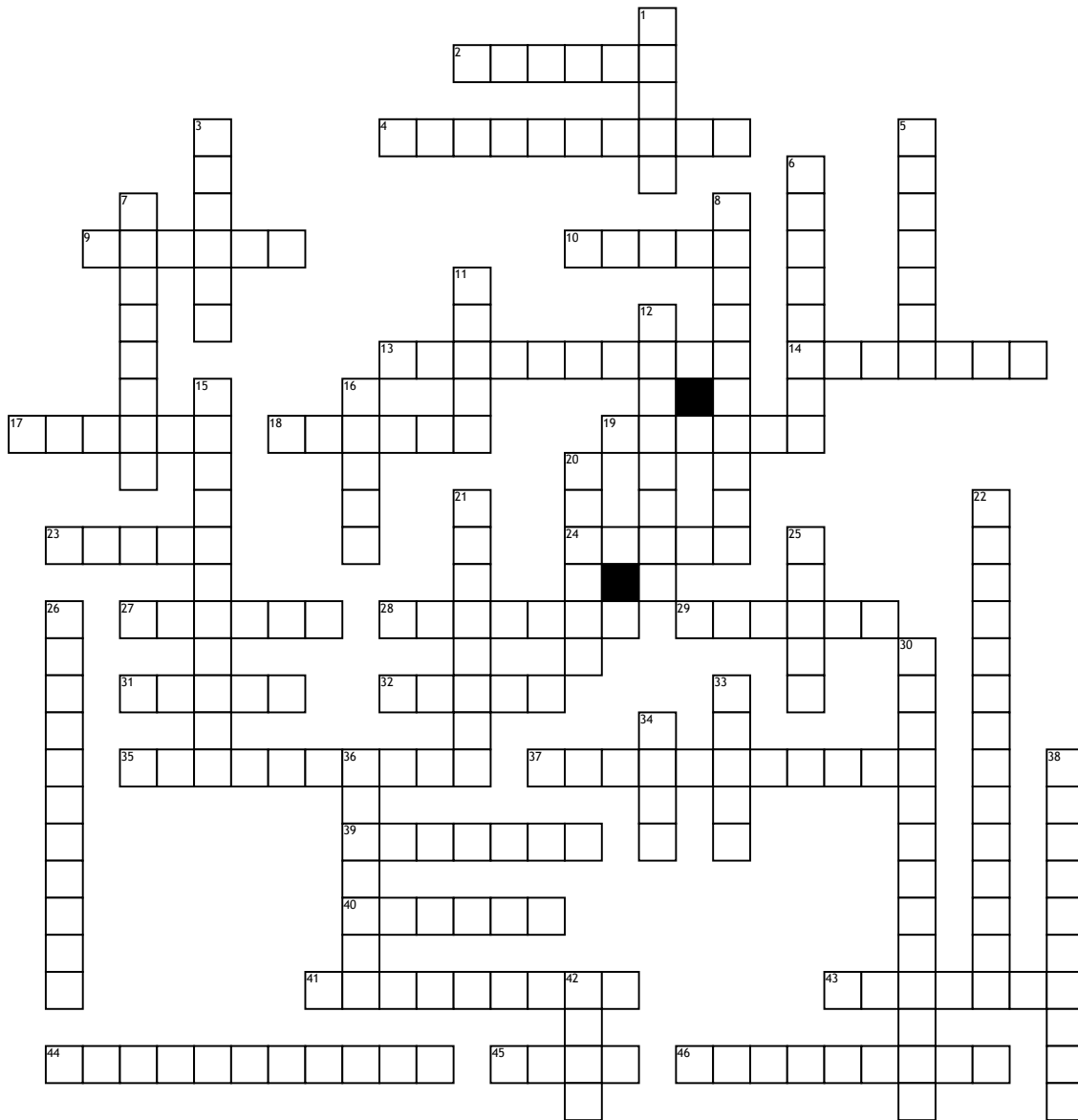

- 2. Spirited, bright, rapid, equalling or exceeding allegro
- 4. Moderately fast, lively. Faster than Andante, slower than allegro
- 9. From the beginning. (D.C. al coda, D.C. al fine)
- 10. All, whole, everyone
- 13. Gradually growing softer. Decrescendo.
- 14. Lively, brisk, rapid
- 17. Fast, rapid
- 18. Slow, leisurely
- 19. Smooth, flowing
- 23. Soft, softly
- 24. Heavy, slow, ponderous in movement. Pronounced "Groovy"
- 27. The quality of a musical tone that distinguishes voices and instruments.
- 28. Spiritedly
- 29. An arrangement of single tones in a meaningful sequence
- 31. Sweetly, softly
- 32. A graduated series of tones arranged in a specified order
- 35. Very soft
- 37. Increase of tempo in music
- 39. The sound resulting from the simultaneous sounding of two or more tones consonant with each other

- 40. Relating to the nineteenth-century musical period characterized by subjectivity on the part of the composer, emotionalism in music, longer musical forms, and richer harmonies.
  - 41. Sustained
  - 43. A rhythmic pulse of 2 against a rhythmic pulse of 3.
  - 44. The rhythmic result produced when a regularly accented beat is displaced onto an unaccented beat.
  - 45. The end of a musical piece

- 1. Slow
  - 3. A small section of a composition comprising a musical thought. Comparable to a sentence in language.
  - 5. Moderately slow, a walking speed
  - 6. Separate. Sounded in a short, detached manner
  - 7. Majestic, dignified
  - 8. A simultaneous sounding of tones that produces a feeling of tension or unrest and a feeling that further resolution is needed.
  - 11. The rate of speed at which a musical composition is performed
  - 12. The distance between two tones
  - 15. Much
  - 16. Large, broad, slow and stately
  - 20. Smooth and connected

- 21. A repeated melodic or rhythmic fragment
- 22. The same tempo. (The tempo remains as before, after a change was made)
- 25. Three or more tones combined and sounded simultaneously
- 26. Expressively
- 30. Music that goes along with a more important part; often harmony or rhythmic patterns accompanying a melody.
- 33. A short musical passage that states an idea. It often provides the basis for variations, development, etc.

- 36. Joke, jest. A sprightly movement, light and humorous in nature
- 38. Gradually growing slower
