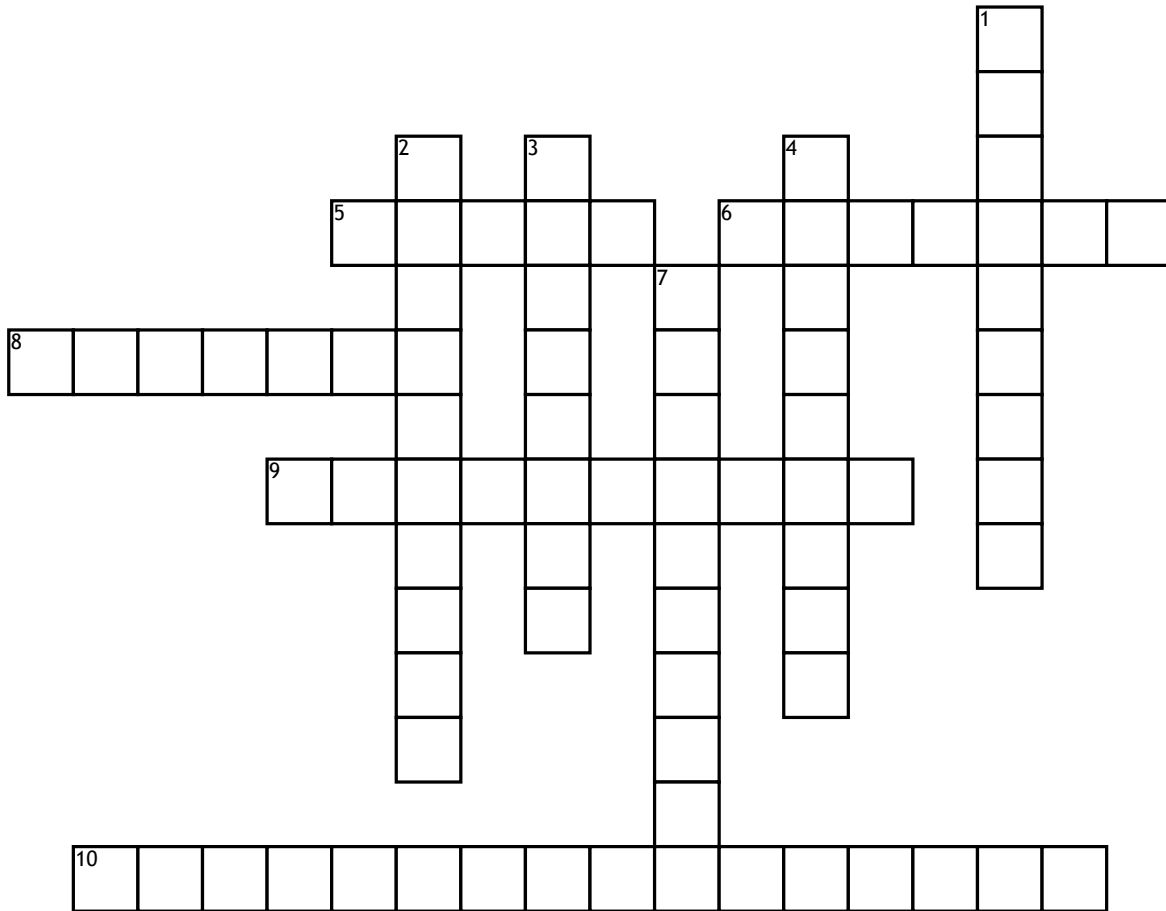

1. Commonly used for planting grasses.
2. Begins with seed planting.
3. The placement of seeds to begin the process of crop growth.
4. uses air pressure and hoses to deposit seeds and fertilizer into trenches within the soil.
7. The application of water to crops during periods which natural rainfall does not meet requirement for plant growth.
