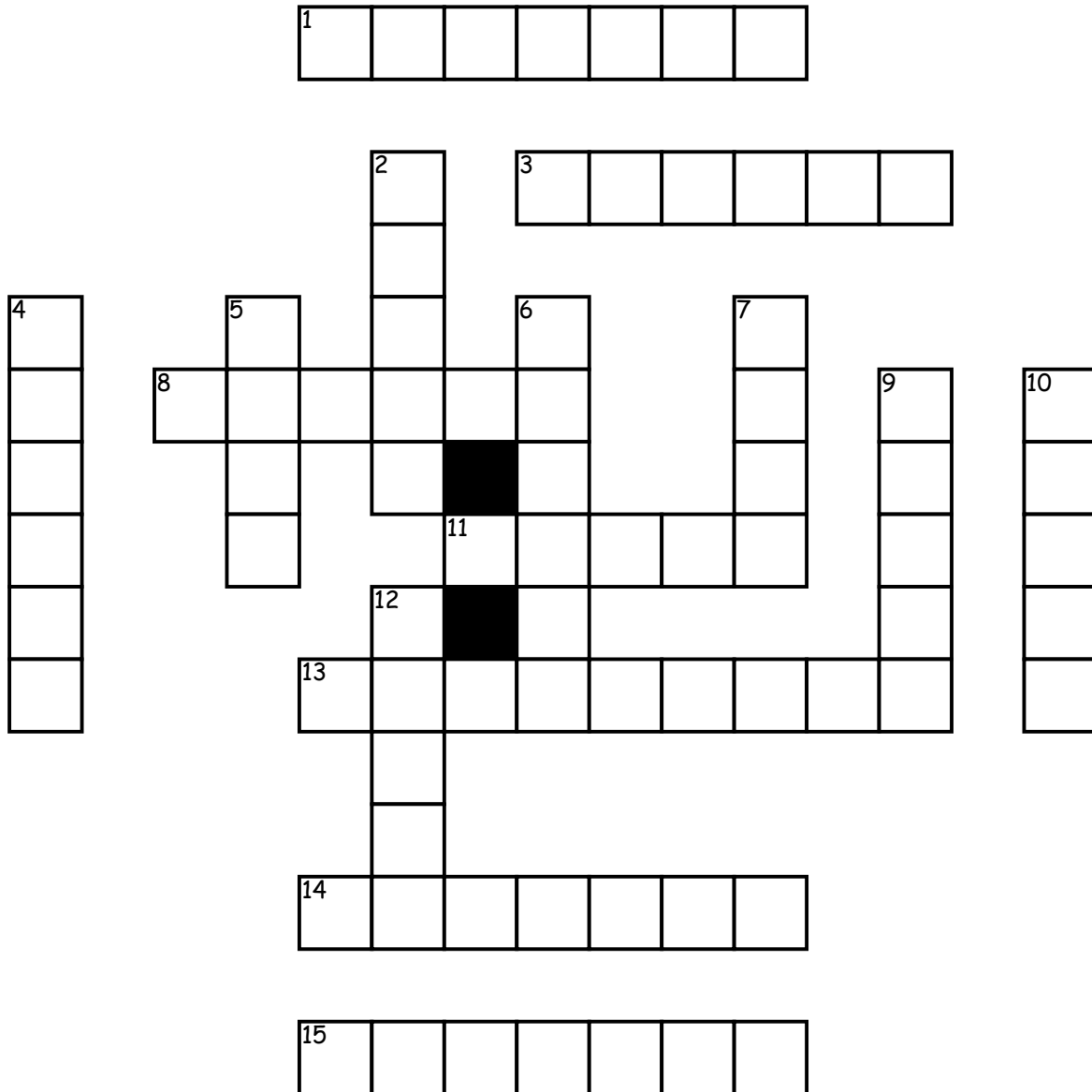


Basic Sewing Terminology



Across

- 1. The narrow, flat, woven boarder
- 3. To draw up fullness
- 8. To treat a raw edge to prevent unraveling
- 11. Frill or ruffle placed at or near neckline
- 13. Narrowest part of the waist
- 14. Mechanism which moves fabric

15. Very necessary for good hand sewing

Down

- 2. Direction the thread is going in the fabric
- 4. Sharp tool for opening seams
- 5. Any diagonal intersection crossing threads
- 6. Cutting tool over 6 inches long

7. Holds the fabric against the feed dog

- 9. Part directly under the needle and the needle passes through
- 10. Tucks sewn in fabric to shape garment to body
- 12. Tool for making accurate measurements
