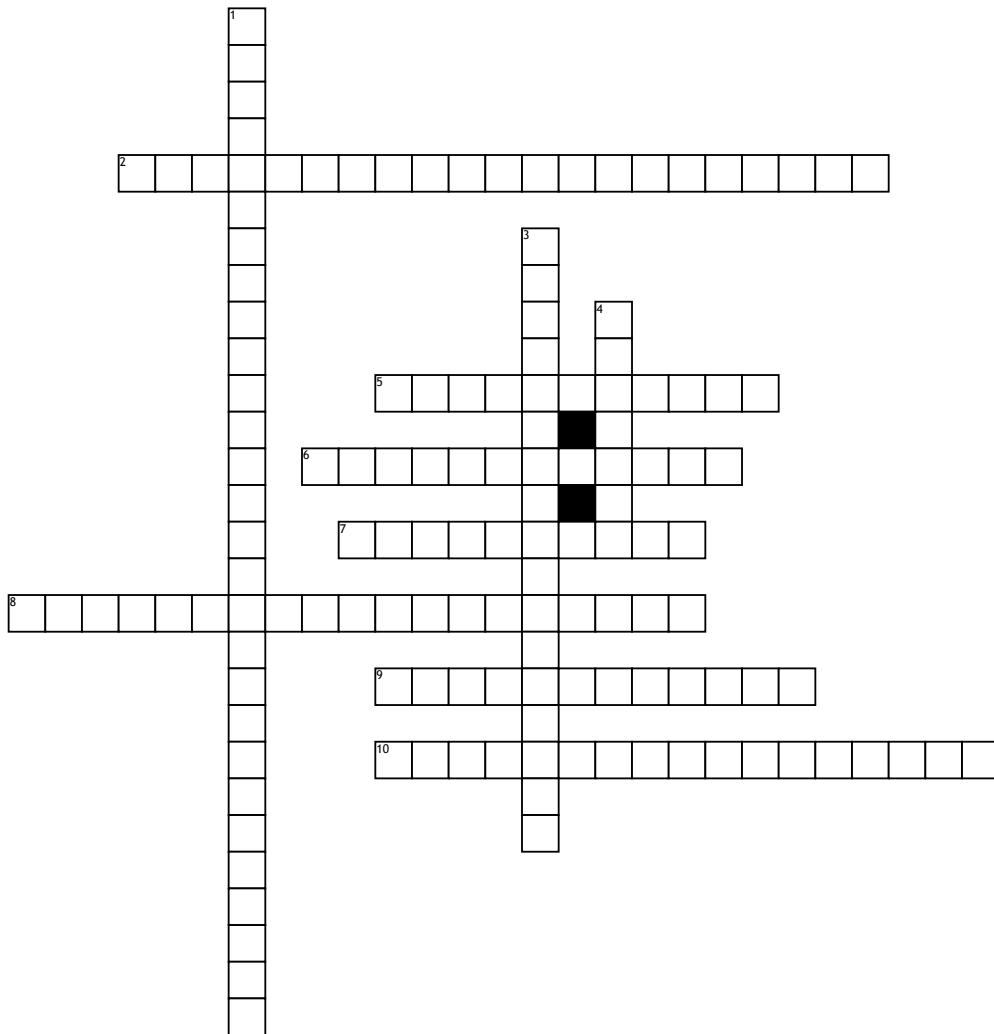


Behaviorism Crossword
