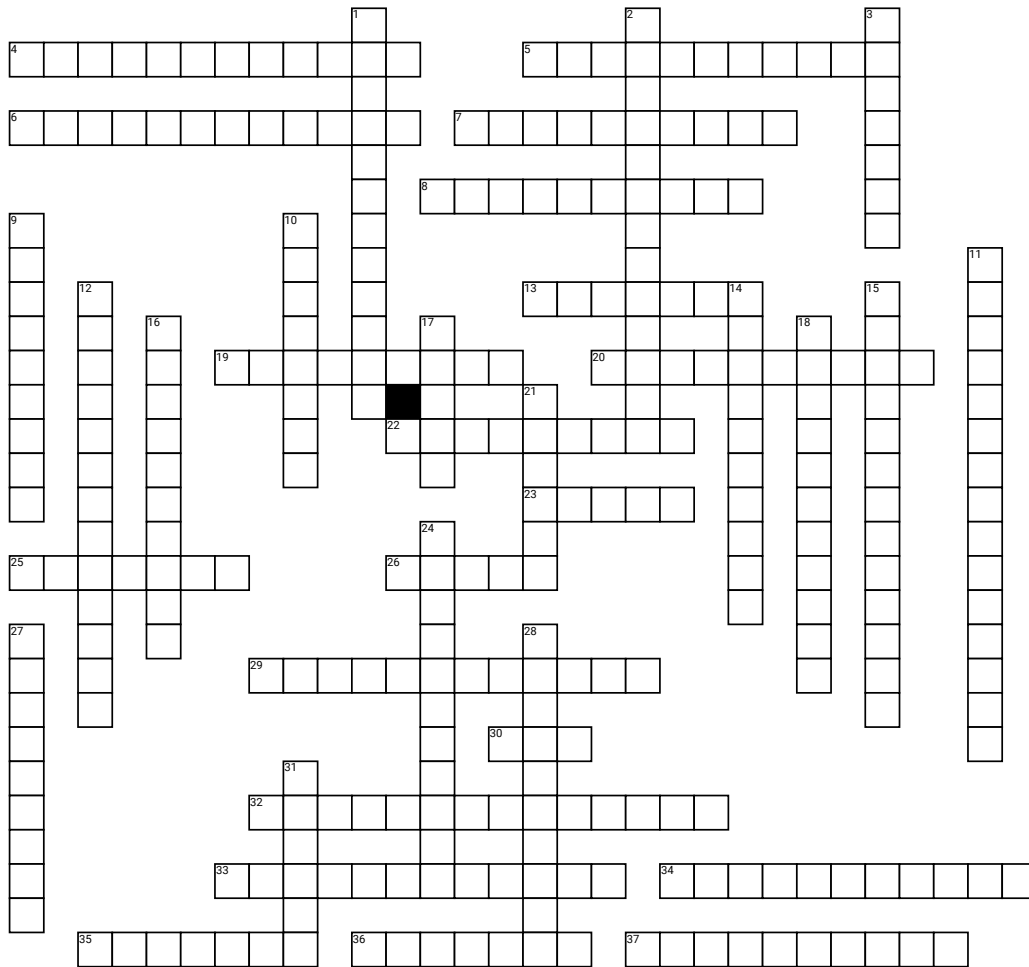

 - 10. an agreement, usually formal, between two or more persons to do or not do something specified
