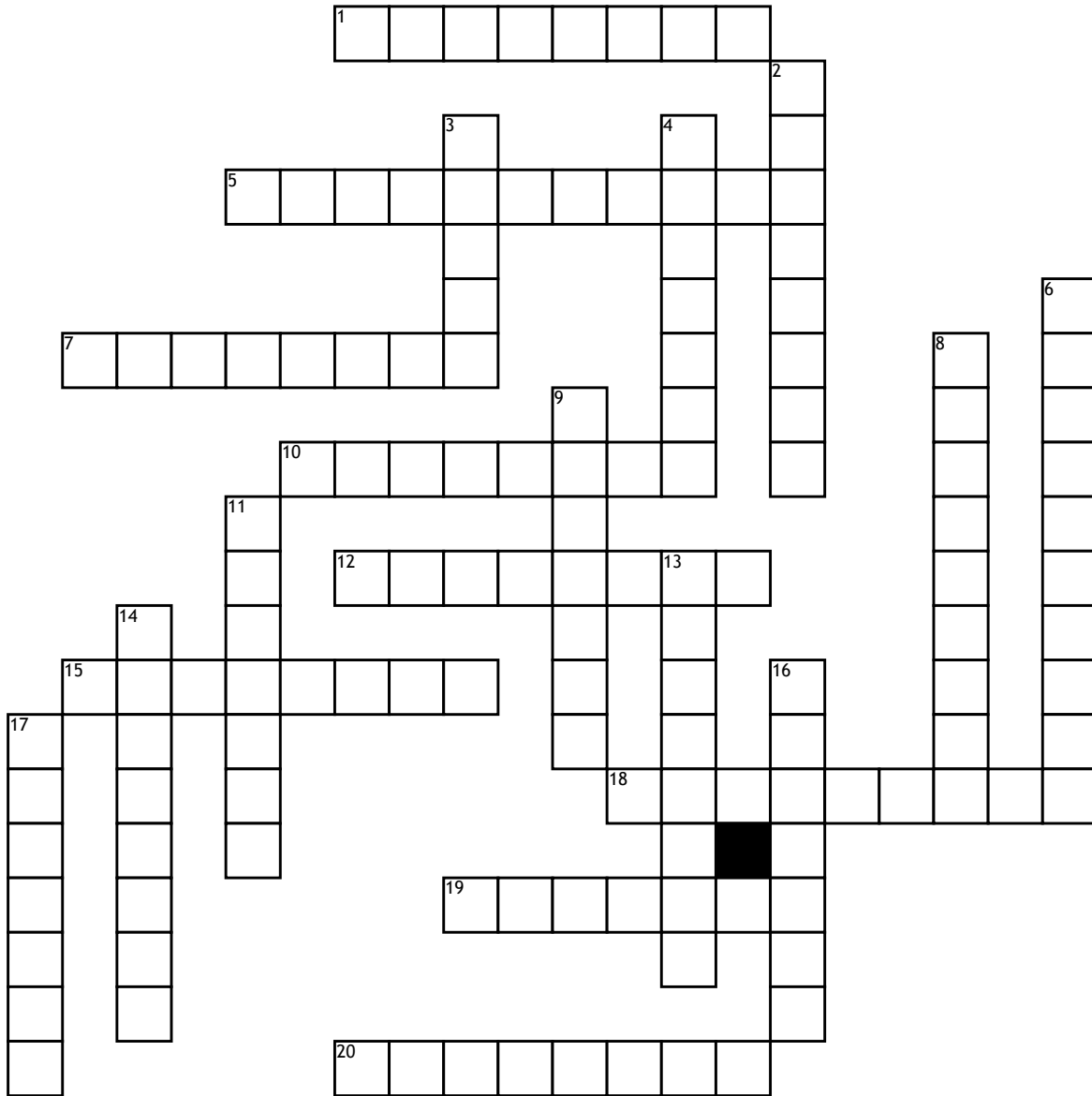


Bill of Rights Crossword
