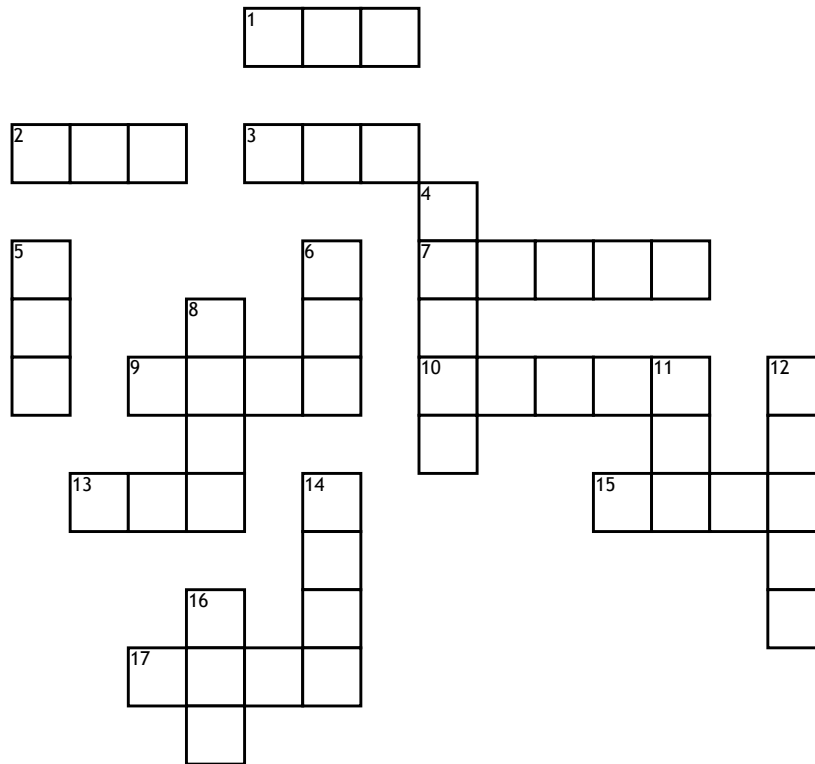


Bill of Rights

- 1. A person has the right to obtain advice from a lawyer if charged with a crime
- 2. A person is entitled to know the charges against him
- 3. A person is entitled to confront witnesses against him and to call witnesses for himself
- 7. People may not be subjected to excessive bail or fines
- 9. A person cannot be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of the law

- 10. People may not be subjected to cruel or unusual punishments
- 13. The right to peacefully assemble
- 15. You cannot be searched or seized without a warrant and reasonable cause
- 17. The listing of some rights in the Constitution does not limit or deny other rights not specifically mentioned

- 4. A jury trial is permitted in civil suits where the value exceeds \$20
