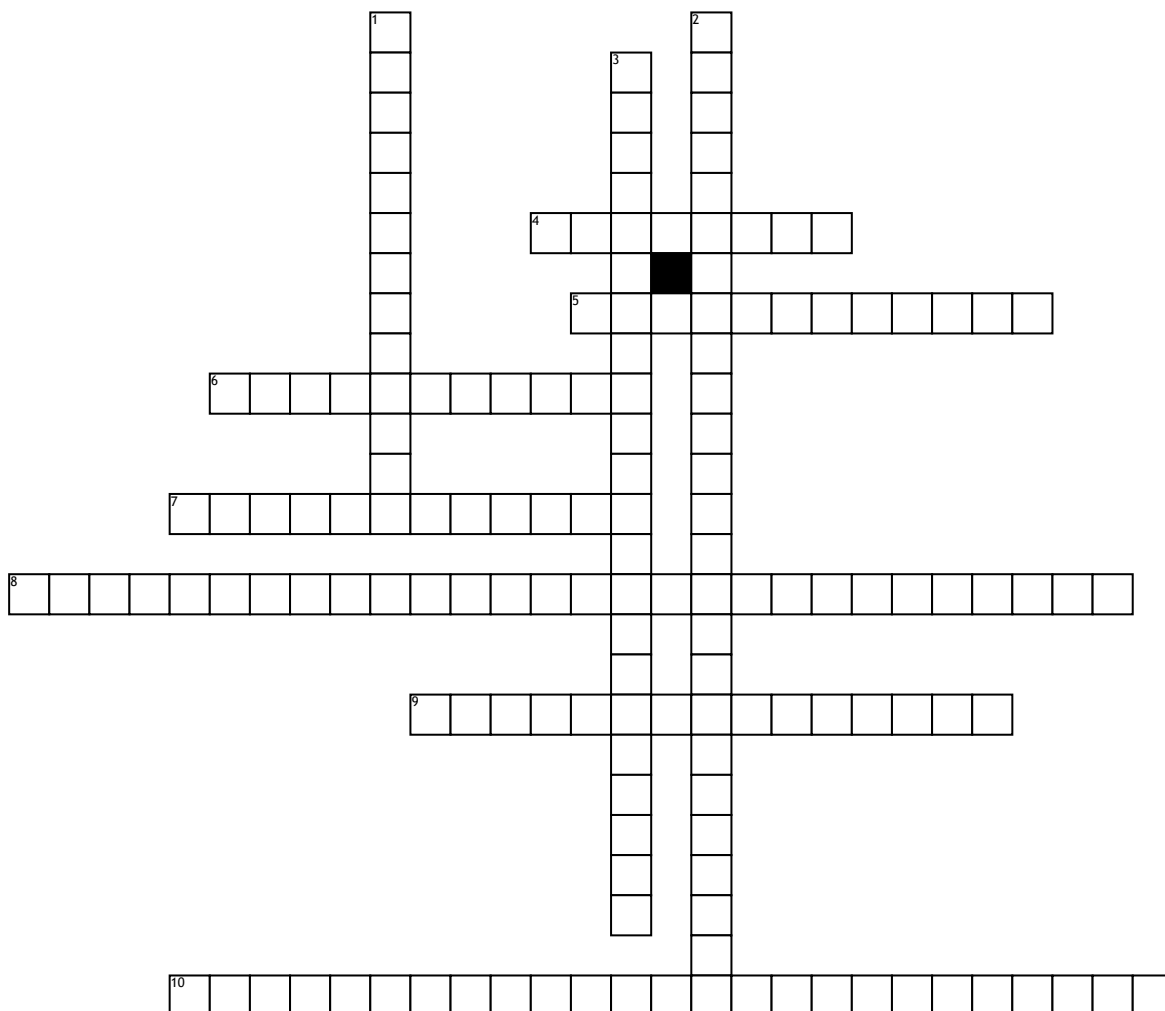


# Birth Impairment



## Across

4. a congenital split in the upper lip on one or both sides of the center.
5. abnormal smallness of the head, a congenital condition associated with incomplete brain development.
6. a congenital defect of the spine in which part of the spinal cord and its meninges are exposed through a gap in the backbone.
7. a congenital disorder arising from a chromosomes defect, causing intellectual impairment and physical abnormalities including short stature and a broad facial profile.

8. a relatively small proportion of birth defects can be attributed, at least in part, to specific environmental cause such as maternal disease.

9. Congenital disorder, is a condition present at birth regardless of its cause.

10. functional or development birth defects cause a body part or system not work properly.

1. a condition marked by impaired muscle coordination and/or other disabilities, typically caused by damage to the brain before or at birth.
2. defects are related to a problem with the structure of the body part.
