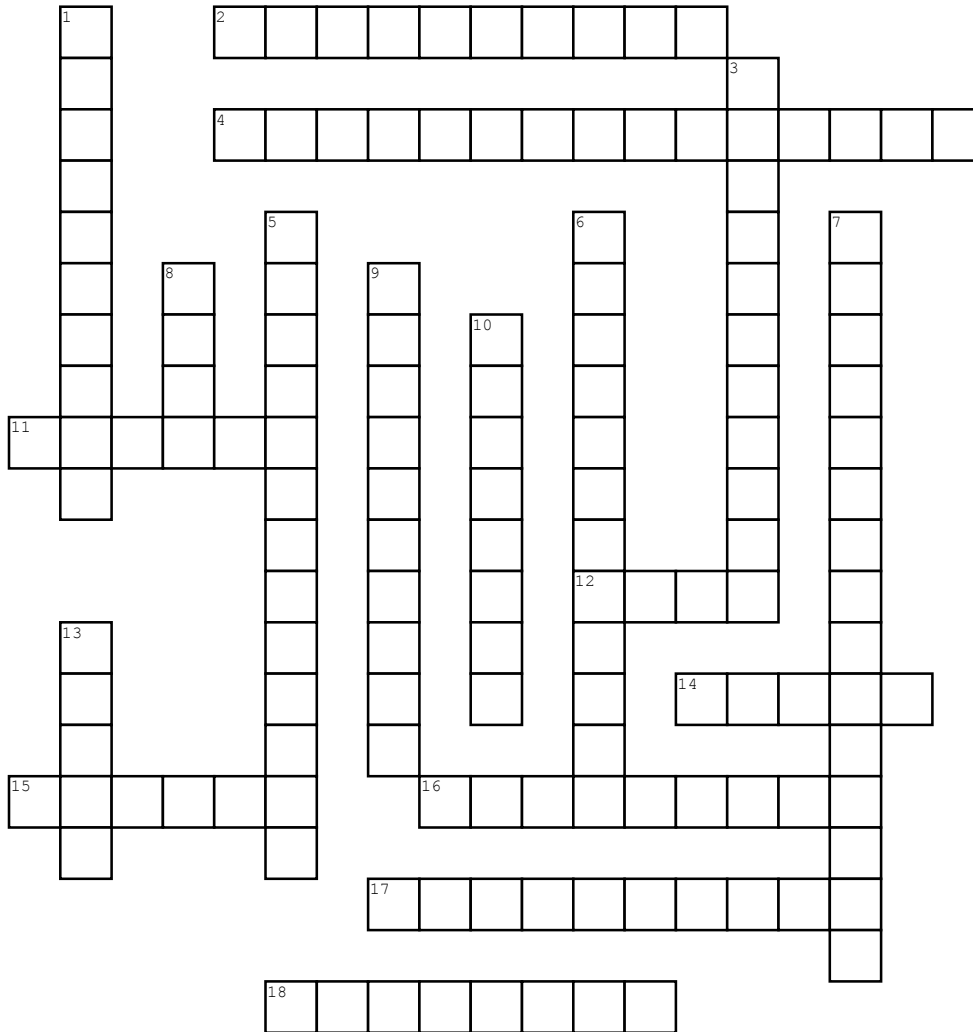


Black Death Crossword

- 2. Originally a 40-day period during which the personnel of a ship suspected of having the plague were obligated to wait before being allowed to go ashore
- 4. the form of the Black Plague where the human's lungs are infected and they become very sick
- 11. the swelling or inflammatory of a lymph gland (usually the armpit or groin area)
- 12. An incurable viral disease that attacks the immune system, This epidemic could be compared the Black Death of the fourteenth century.
- 14. Paralysis is any part of the body; it is sometimes accompanied by involuntary shaking

- 15. From the Latin word, "morbus," meaning disease. It refers to anything which is diseased or is caused by disease.
- 16. a well or pit which holds usually filthy water or sewage from homes
- 17. A destructive, swiftly spreading disease, such as the bubonic plague
- 18. A widespread outbreak of an infectious disease (global-scale).

- 3. a religious group that whipped and hit themselves to repent their sins
- 5. The "art of dying," practiced by some people at the time of the Black Death. The goal of this practice was to approach death with a calm and peaceful outlook and to enter the kingdom of heaven

- 6. Latin term for a Black rat which began the Plague from Asia to Europe
- 7. A system of glands and vessels that distribute substance called lymph. The buboes from which the Bubonic Plague takes its name, are swollen lymph glands.
- 8. Swollen, discolored lymph node; common symptom of the Black Death
- 9. The Medieval black plague that ravaged Europe and killed a third of its population
- 10. A widespread outbreak of an infectious disease (can be within a city, state, or country)
- 13. large city in Italy. Genome tradesmen returned the seas to Genoa bringing the Plague with them
