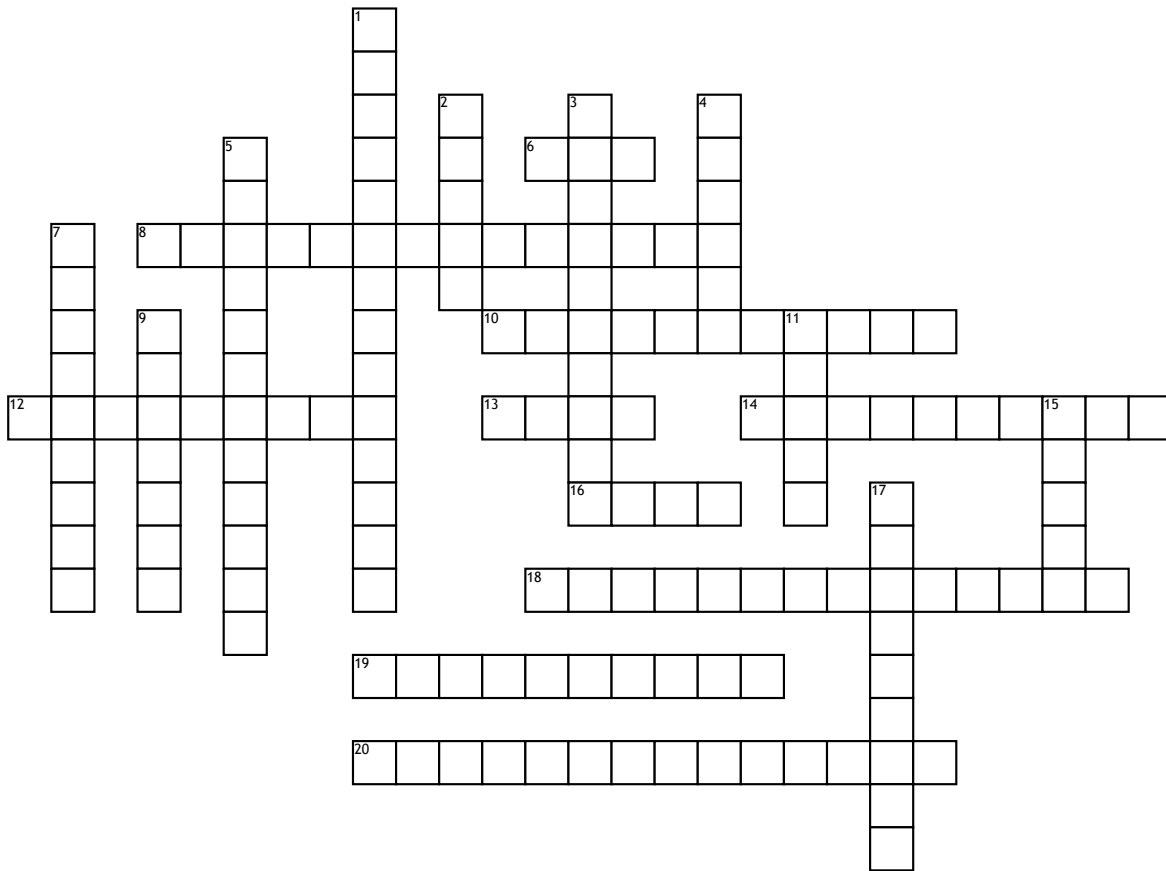


Black Musicians Throughout the Decades

14. Blind visionary of soul music during the 50s who earned the title of "The Genius."

16. Founder of the record label Roc-A-Fella Records and Tidal Music. He also has a successful career in singing.

18. A singer and actress, her powerful voice has made her the most awarded female artist of all time in the Guinness Book of World Records.

19. Icon and singer of "What's Love Got to Do with It." She has also been as "The Queen of Rock 'n' Roll."

20. The "King of Pop" and former member of a band that he performed with his brothers in.

1. Influential trumpet player with a career lasting from the 20s to the 60s. He is often considered the father of jazz.

2. Rapper and producer primarily known for his work in the 80s and 90s. He founded and named a line of headphones named after himself.

3. Female rapper of the past couple decades who wears bold outfits and bright wigs. Her most famous hits include "Starships" and "Super Bass."

4. One of the greatest artists of his generation, he played countless instruments and wrote many songs for other artists. His hits include "Purple Rain" and "1999."

5. "I Just Called to Say I love You" and "Superstition" blind singer of the late 20th century.

7. "No Woman No Cry" singer who pioneered the genre of reggae.

9. Singer songwriter with albums including "Lemonade" and "B'Day" who used to be part of the band Destiny's Child.

11. Canadian singer, actor, rapper, and entrepreneur with hits including "Hotline Bling" and "God's Plan."

15. Current pop star with hits including "Truth Hurts" and "Juice" who also happens to play the flute.

17. Rapper and singer of the 90s with songs including "What's My Name" and "Gin & Juice." He is also well known for his adventures in cooking and has published his own cookbook.
