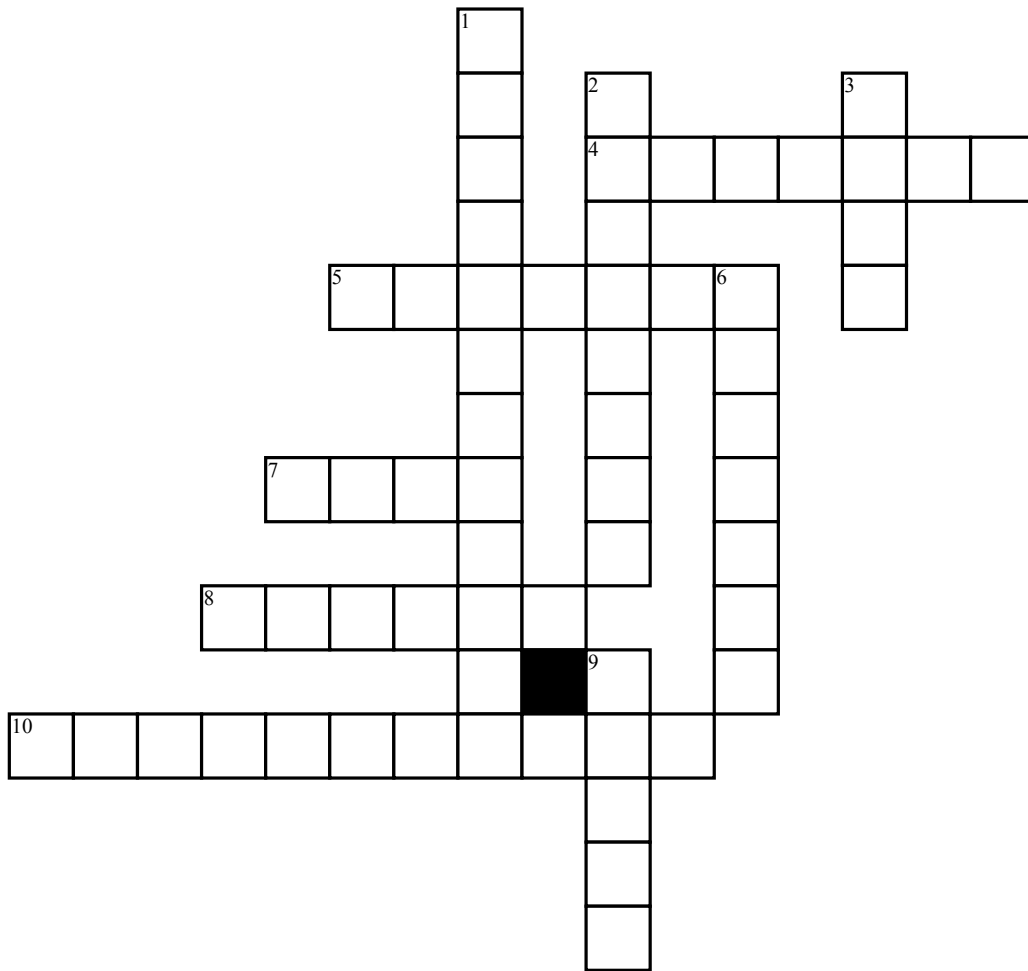


Bleak House Crossword!
