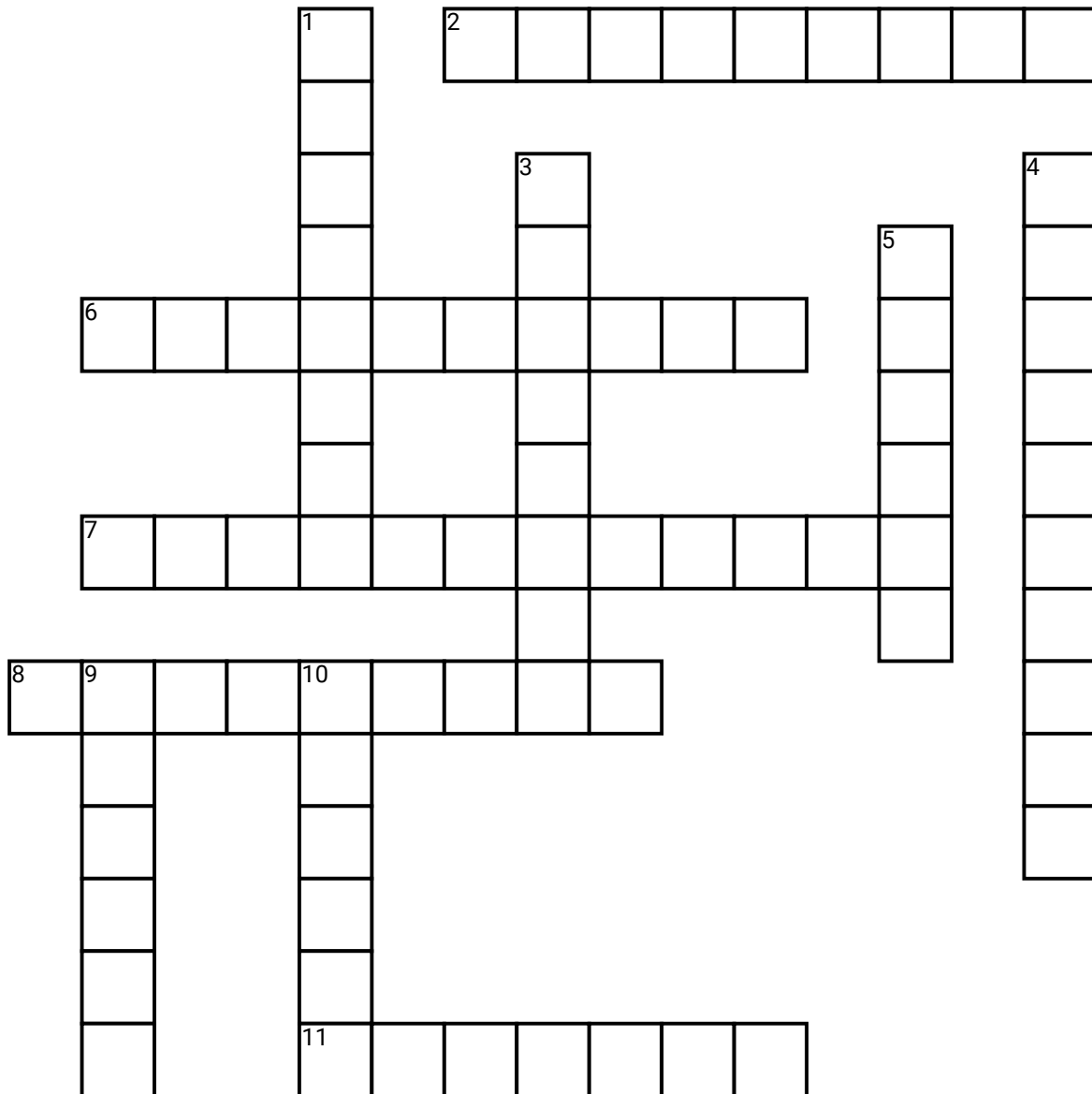


Bodies From the Ice Crossword
