| 1. Largest body of water.  | A. Ocean             |
| 2. Salt water body of water smaller than an ocean, and partly enclosed by a landmass, but are open to the sea.                     | B. Pond              |
| 3. Salt water body of water that is smaller than a sea, and surrounded by land on three sides with the third side open to the sea. | C. Gulf              |
| 4. Salt water body of water that is smaller than a sea and is partly enclosed by a landmass, but is mostly open to a sea or ocean. | D. Wetland           |
| 5. Brackish water area where rivers meet the ocean.  | E. Lagoon            |
| 6. A narrow body of water that connects two larger bodies of water.  | F. Brook             |
| 7. A lake that is separated from the ocean by a narrow band of rocks and sand.   | G. Estuary           |
| 8. A large frozen body of freshwater.  | H. Glacier           |
| 9. Body of water that is surrounded by land. It can be fresh or saltwater.   | I. Bay               |
| 10. Freshwater body of water surrounded by land and is smaller than a lake.  | J. Sea               |
| 11. A steady flow of water on land.  | K. Stream            |
| 12. A freshwater stream of water flowing out to the ocean.   | L. River             |
