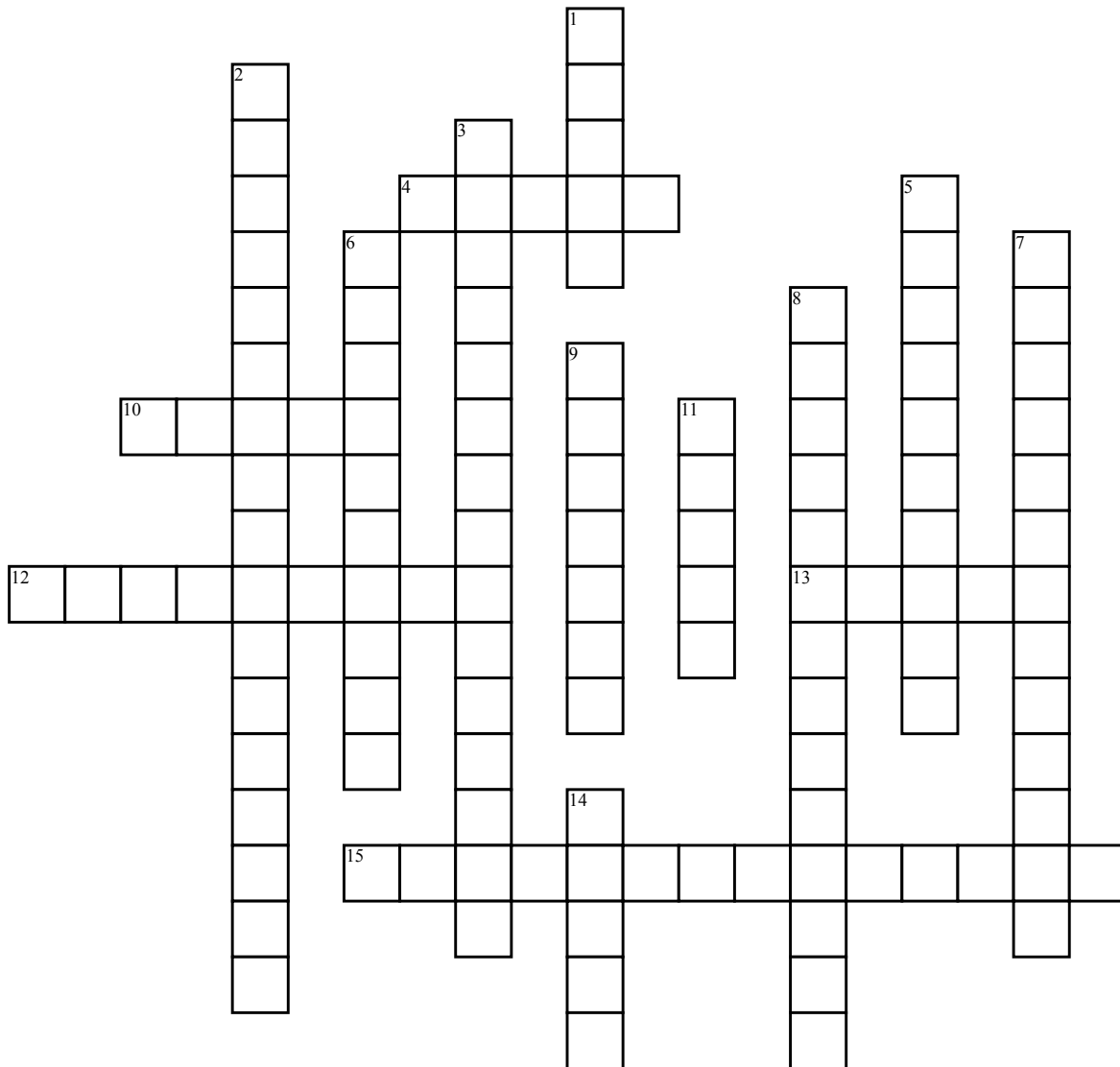

- 4. each of a pair of organs in the abdominal cavity of mammals, birds, and reptiles, excreting urine.
- 10. an organ of soft nervous tissue contained in the skull of vertebrates
- 12. a hollow part or cavity in an organ
- 13. each of the pair of organs situated within the rib cage, consisting of elastic sacs with branching passages into which air is drawn
- 15. The framework of the body, consisting of bones and other connective tissues, which protects and supports the body tissues and internal organs

- 1. a large lobed glandular organ in the abdomen of vertebrates
- 2. the system that circulates blood and lymph through the body, consisting of the heart, blood vessels, blood, lymph, and the lymphatic vessels and glands
- 3. the system by which ingested food is acted upon by physical and chemical means to provide the body with absorbable nutrients and to excrete waste products
- 5. the lower part of the alimentary canal from the end of the stomach to the anus

- 6. the cylindrical bundle of nerve fibers and associated tissue which is enclosed in the spine and connects nearly all parts of the body to the brain
- 7. the network of nerve cells and fibers which transmits nerve impulses between parts of the body
- 8. an organ system consisting of skeletal, smooth and cardiac muscles
- 9. the internal organ in which the major part of the digestion of food occurs
- 11. any of the tubes forming part of the blood circulation system of the body
- 14. a hollow muscular organ that pumps the blood through the circulatory system by rhythmic contraction and dilation.
