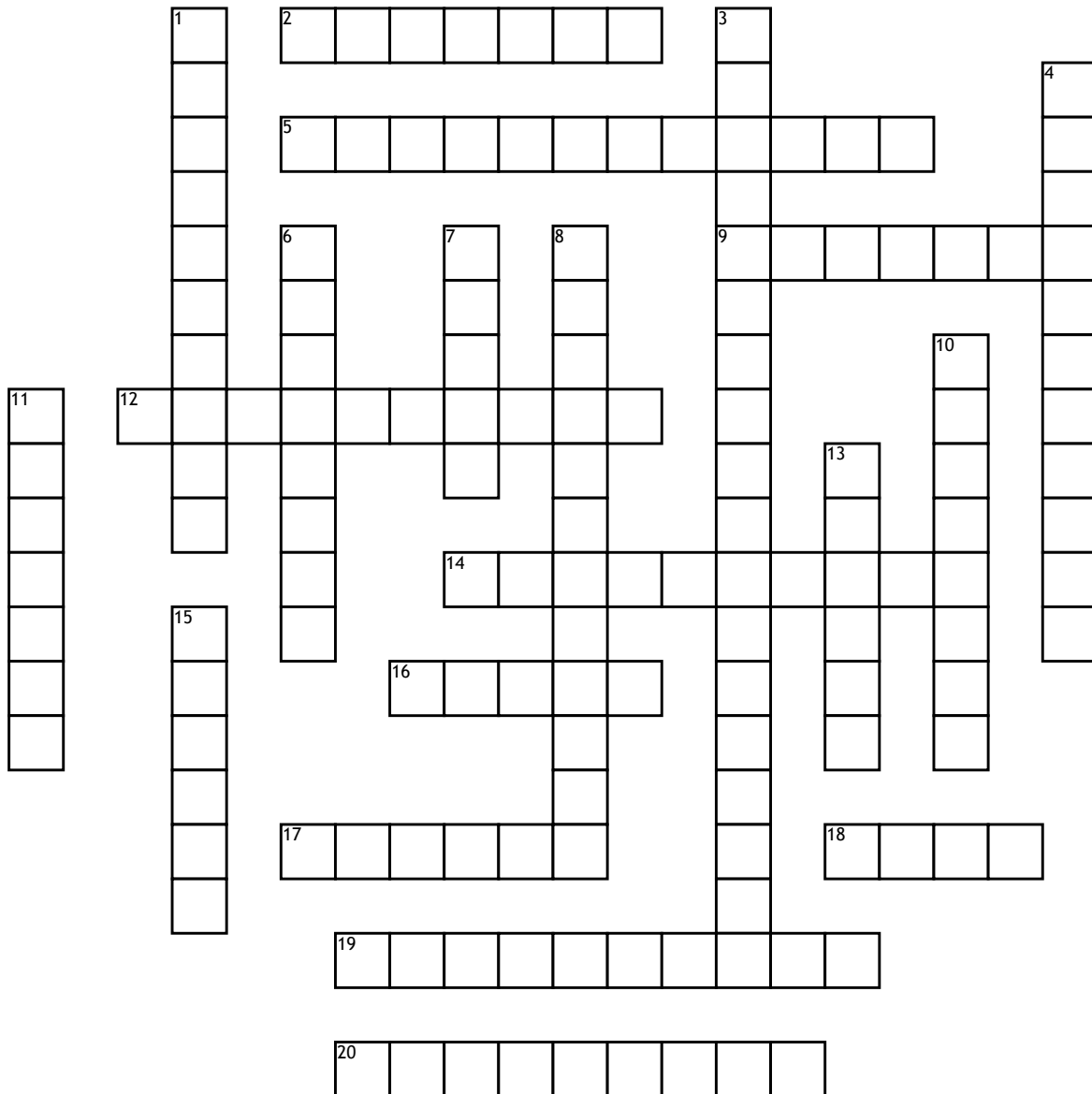


Bones
