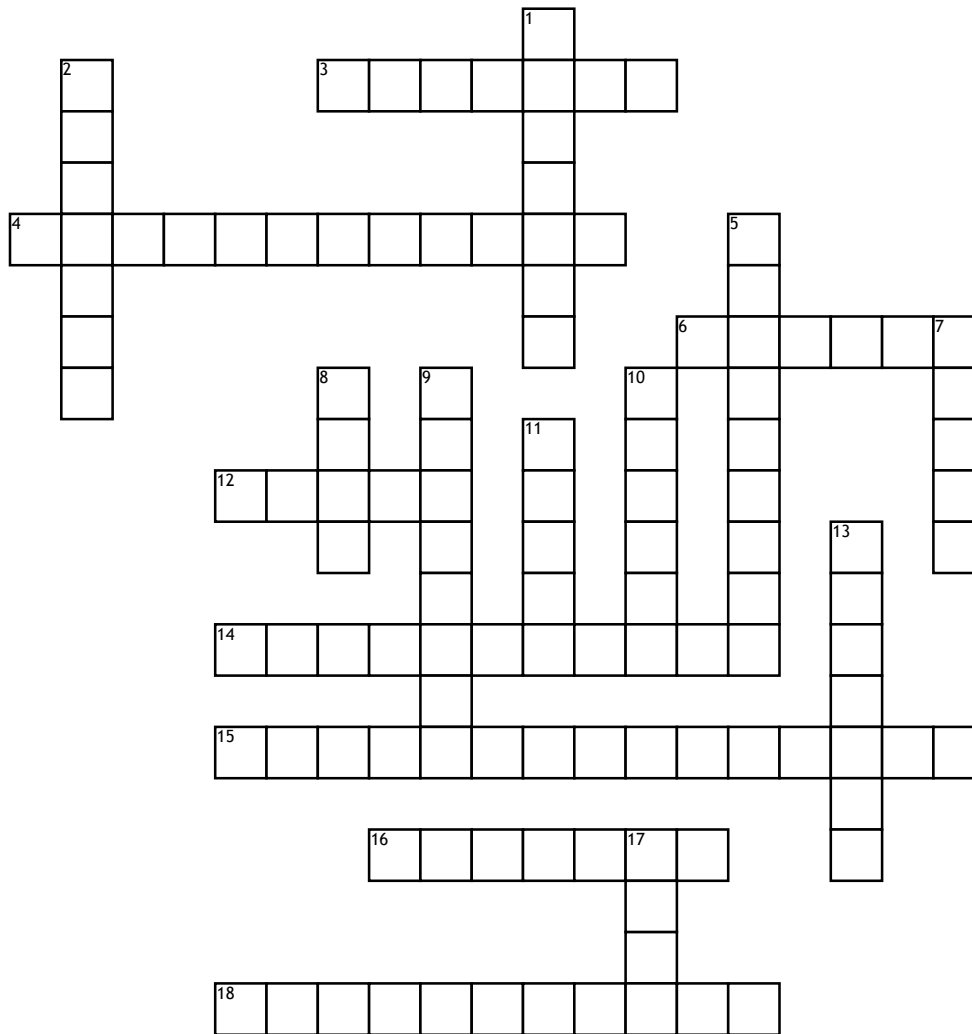


Bones Crossword
