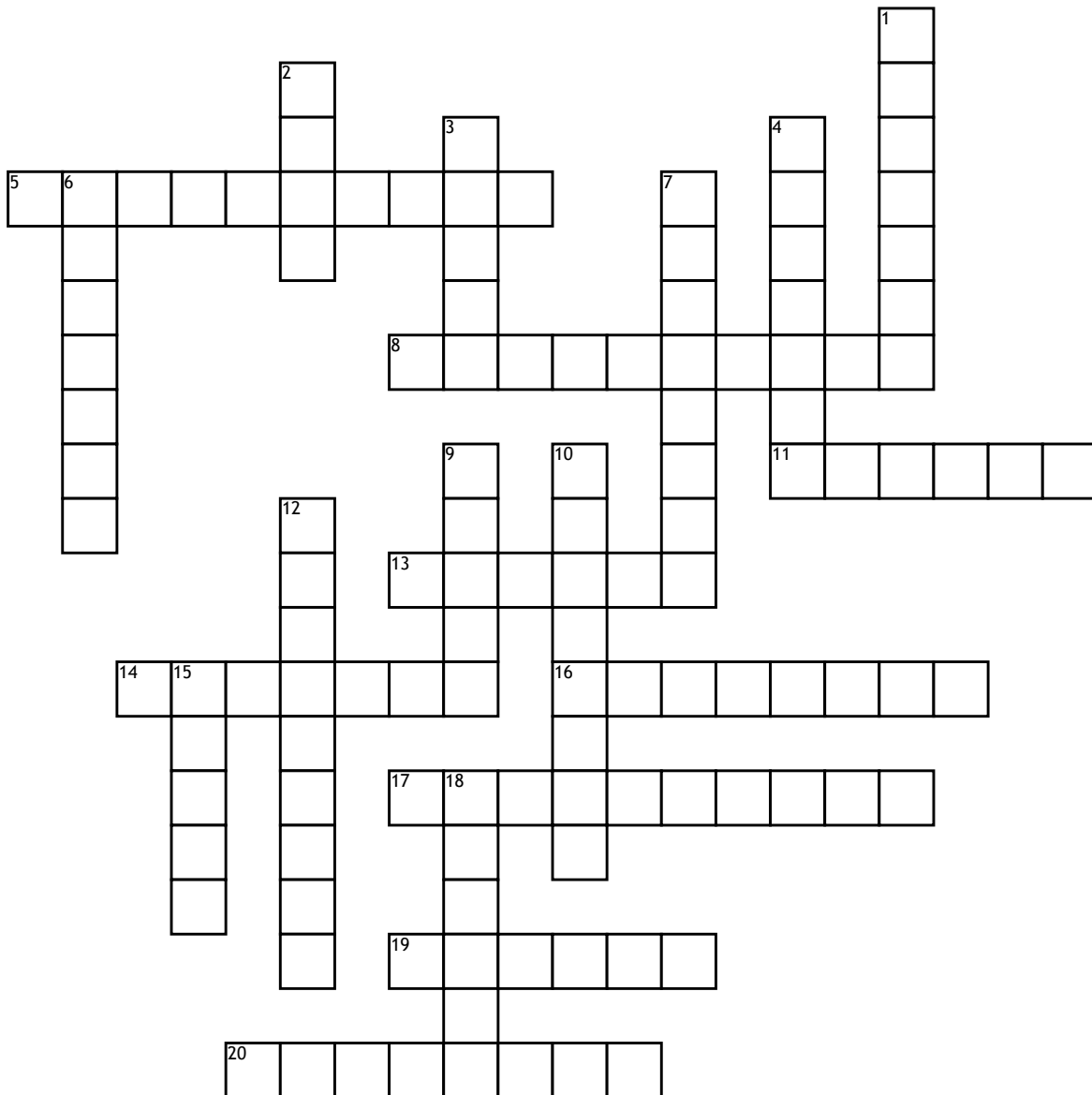


Bones & Fractures

- 5. A fracture in which the bone breaks into many pieces
- 8. A fracture that happens across the bone in a straight line
- 11. Uneven bone s-shaped at the end when pressure is applied to the fixed bone.
- 13. A fracture that does not break the skin and the bone is not exposed
- 14. (Breastbone) located in the center of the chest it connects to the ribs

- 16. A fracture in which the ends of the bone goes through soft tissue and skin
- 17. When the bone bends in which is an incomplete fracture
- 19. The calf bone
- 20. fracture when the bone piece is tugged off by a tendon or ligament that is attached to it.

- 1. Also known as thoracic cage
- 2. One of the two bones of the forearm
- 3. The thigh Bone

- 4. a long bone in the arm that runs from the shoulder to the elbow.
- 6. Fracture is diagonal, used when describing a fracture to a long bone
- 7. The collarbone
- 9. Largest part of the hip bone
- 10. When a bone collides into another piece of bone.
- 12. This happens more often on flat bones when pushed inward
- 15. The larger and stronger bone in the leg below the knee
- 18. One of the two bones in the forearm
