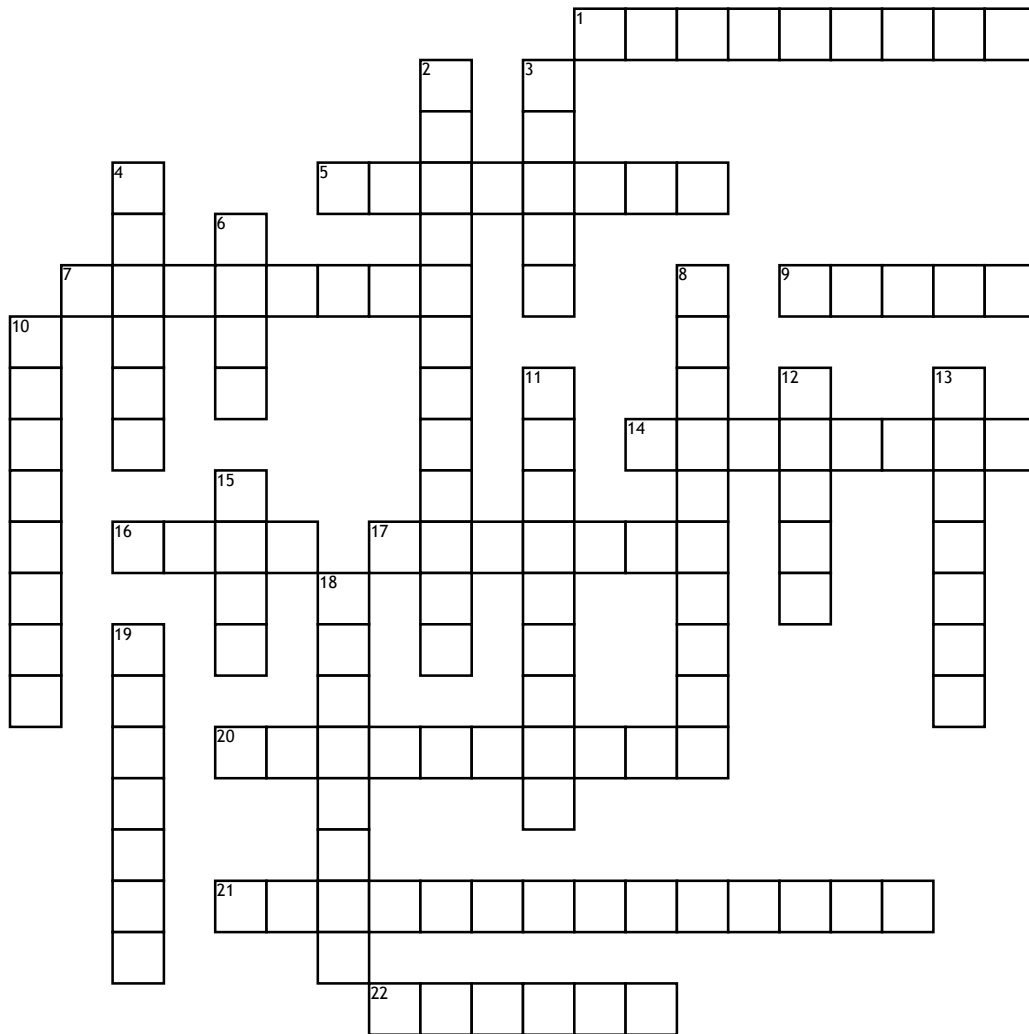


Boy Were We Wrong About Dinosaurs
