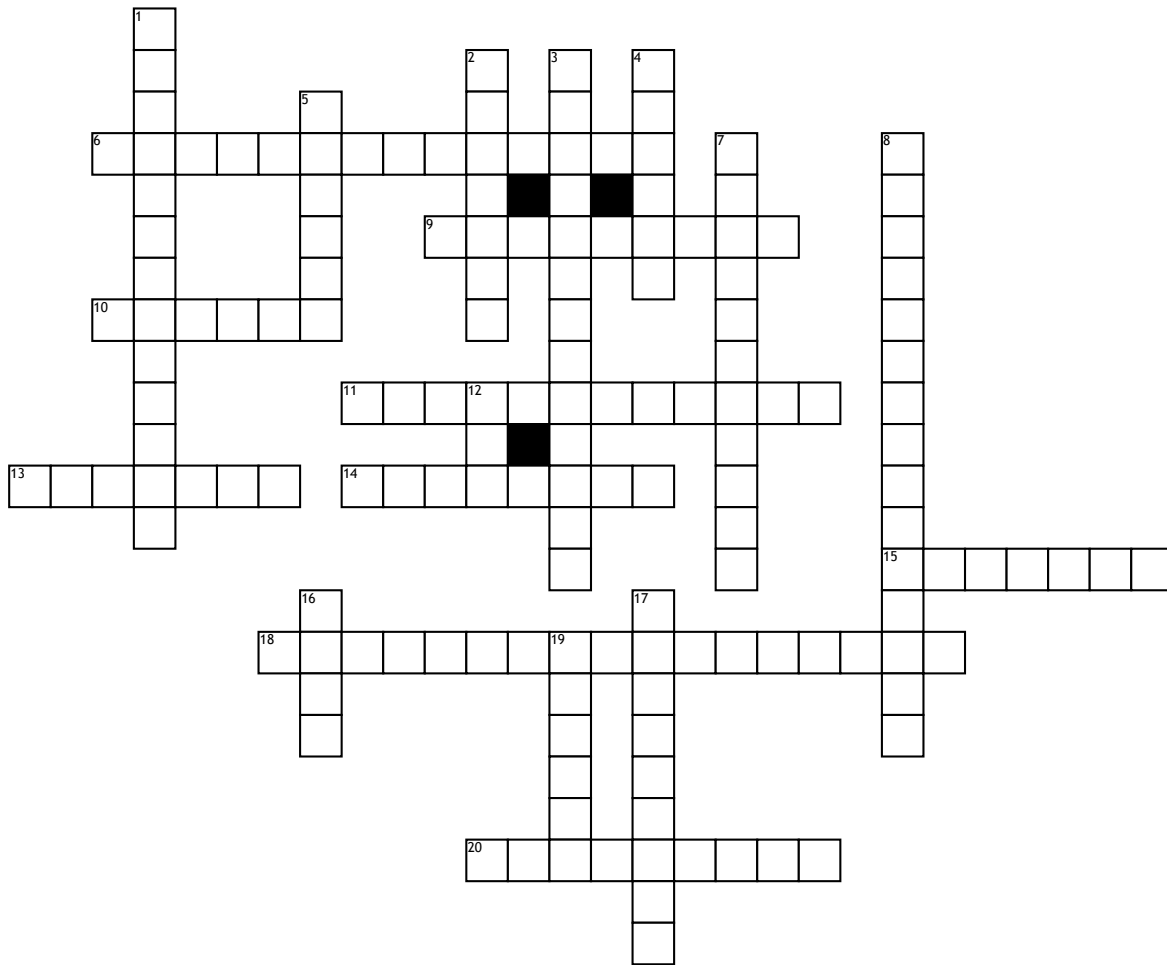


# Brain Cancer Crossword
