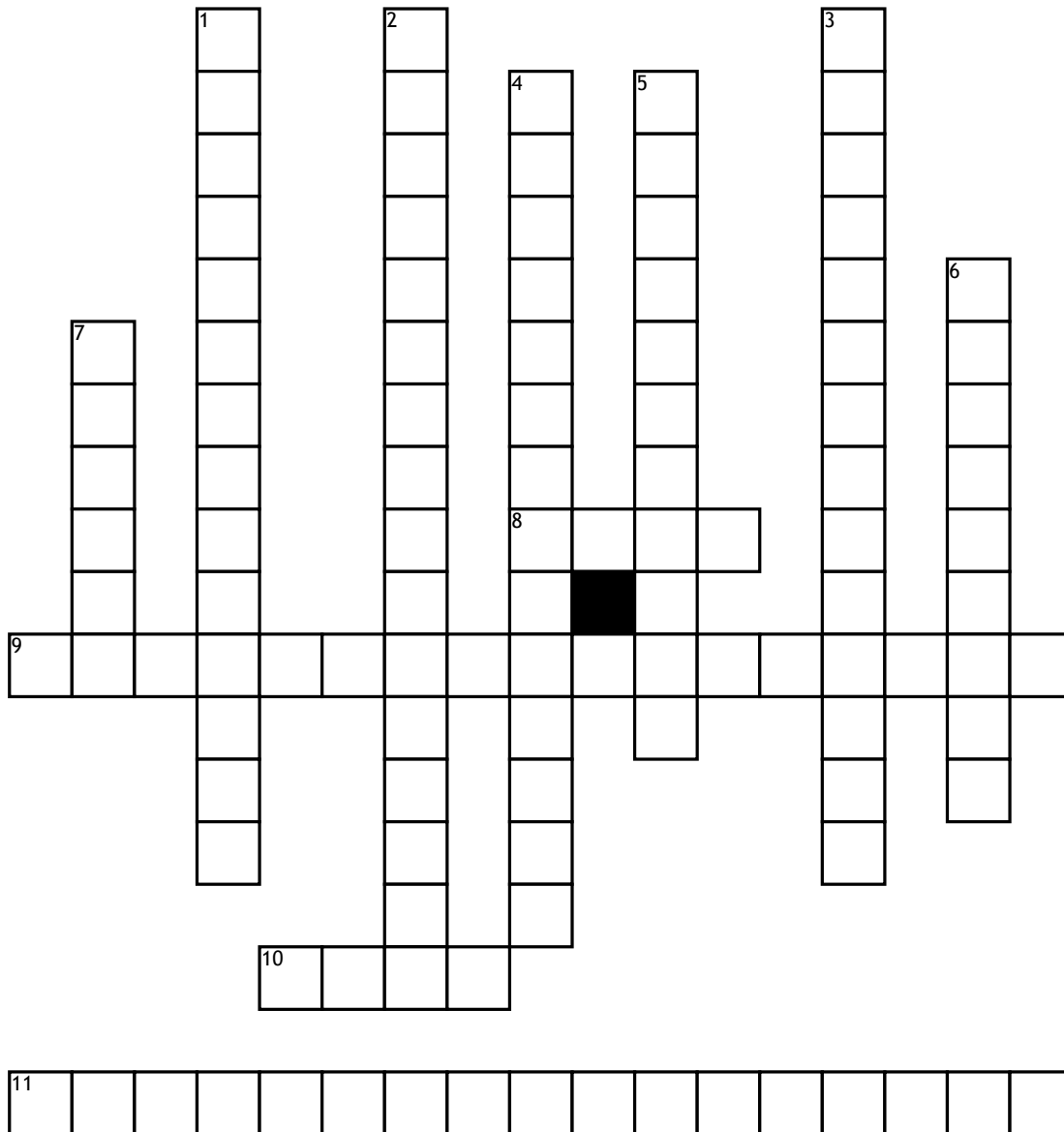


Branches of Government
