Breastfeeding

1. lack of adequate milk making tissue
 2. stage of lactation when breasts are full and heavy
 3. may cause delayed lactogenesis II
 4. inhibits prolactin from attaching to its receptor
 5. sometimes causes low milk production
 6. dark area around the nipple
 7. sound heard during feeds that suggest ineffective latch
 8. organ that prevents prolactin from acting
