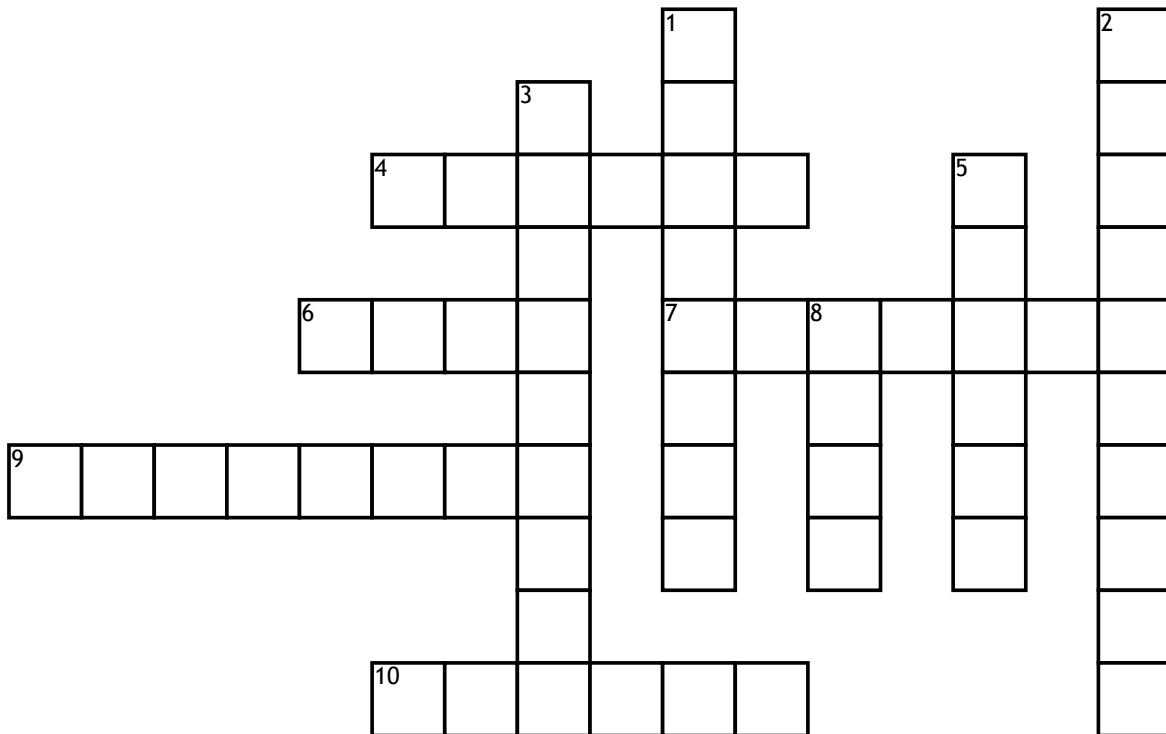

6. also called Chinese gooseberry, woody vine and edible fruit of the family Actinidiaceae.
7. (*Brassica oleracea*), vegetable and fodder plant of the mustard family
9. genus of 60-70 species of flowering plants in the family Amaranthaceae
10. any of various trees belonging to the genus *Prunus* and their edible fruits

1. form of cabbage, of the mustard family, grown for its edible flower buds and stalk.
2. also called pomelo, citrus tree of the Rutaceae family and its edible fruit.
3. large thistlelike perennial plant of the aster family (Asteraceae) grown for its edible flower buds.
5. any of several species of small trees or shrubs of the genus *Citrus* of the family Rutaceae and their nearly round fruits
8. any of the four cultivated forms of the plant *Beta vulgaris* grown for their edible leaves and roots
