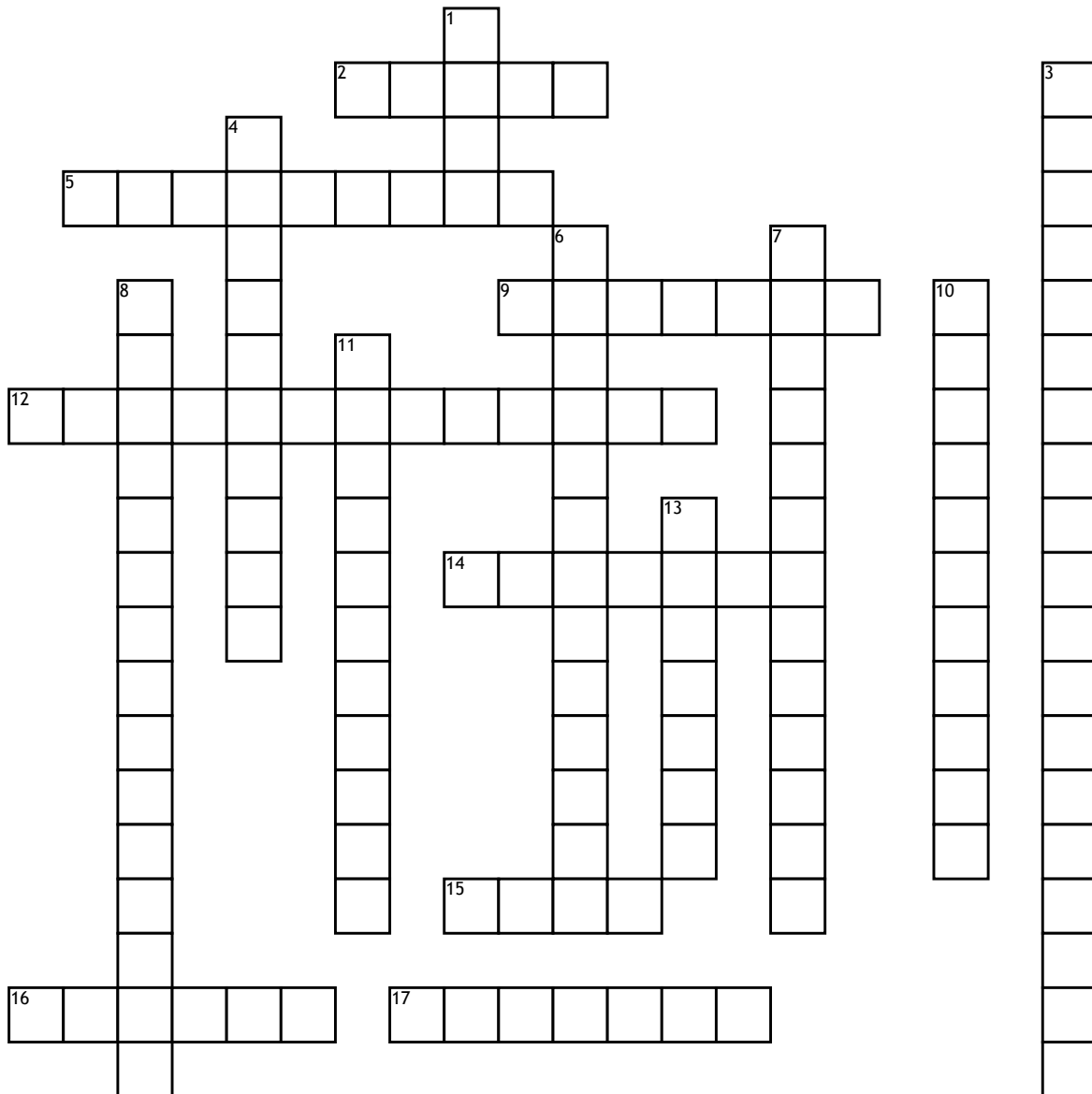

- 2. Is what food is eaten through and possibility of breathing
- 5. Muscular partition beneath the lungs located in the abdomen
- 9. Tiny air sacs in lungs for rapid gaseous exchange
- 12. Carries oxygenated blood from the lungs to the heart
- 14. Extends from larynx to bronchial tubes and conveys air to the lungs

- 15. Contains nostrils for breathing and smelling
 - 16. Forms air passage to lungs and has vocal cords
 - 17. Composed of the true vocal cords and vestibule folds
- ## Down
- 1. Is damaged to much extent by smoking
 - 3. Formed by the alveoli and the capillaries
 - 4. A flap of cartilage at the root of the tongue and covers the windpipe for swallowing

- 6. Connect the bronchioles to the alveolar sacs
- 7. Help maintain equal air pressure throughout the lung and alveoli
- 8. Carries blood to the lungs for oxygenation
- 10. Large air-filled space behind the nose in the middle of the face
- 11. Forms a network between arterioles and venules
- 13. Cavity behind the nose and mouth that connects to the esophagus
