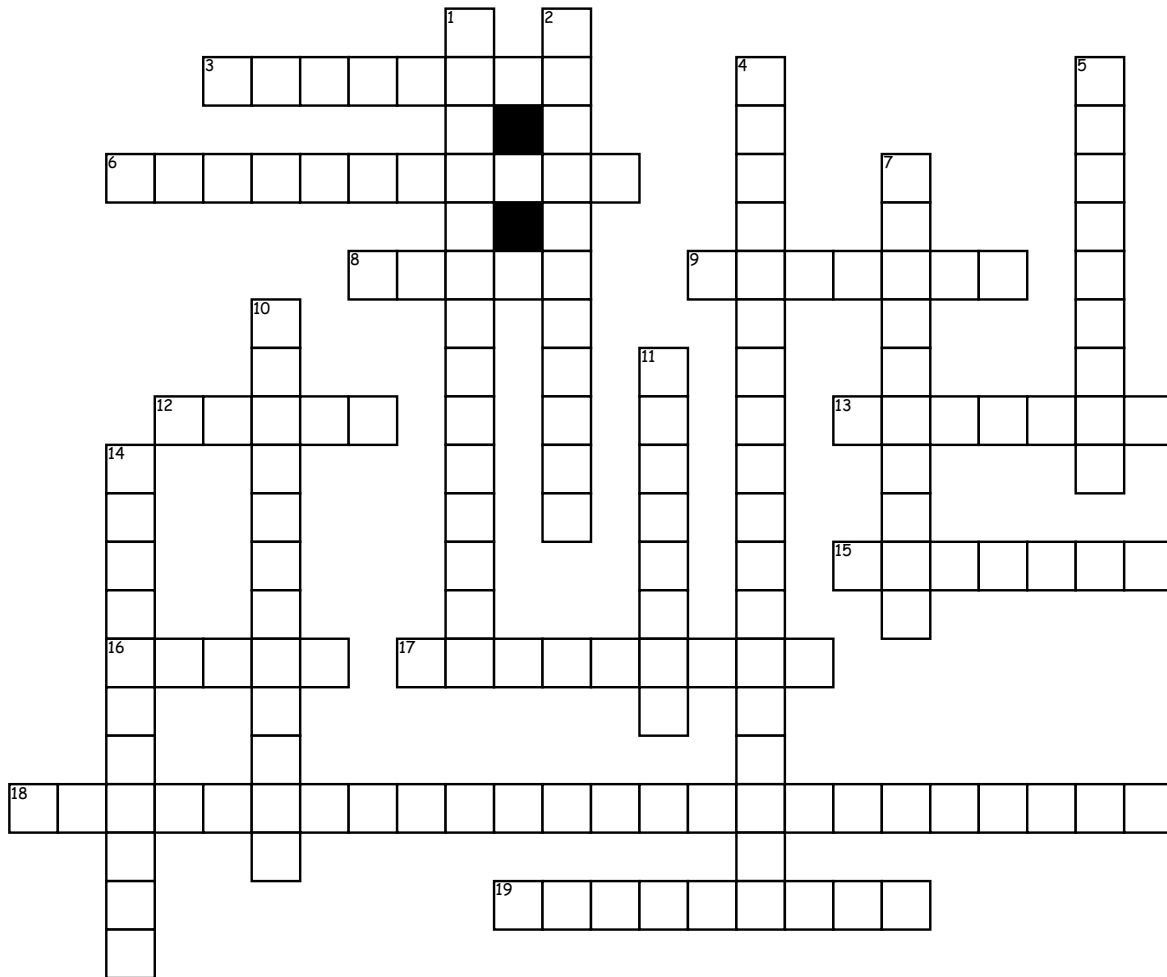

- 9. a movement originally for the re-establishment and (now) the development and protection of a Jewish nation in what is now Israel. It was established as a political organization in 1897

Hussein defied security council demands to withdraw from Kuwait by mid-January 1991, and the Persian Gulf War began with a massive US-led air offensive known as Operation Desert Storm
