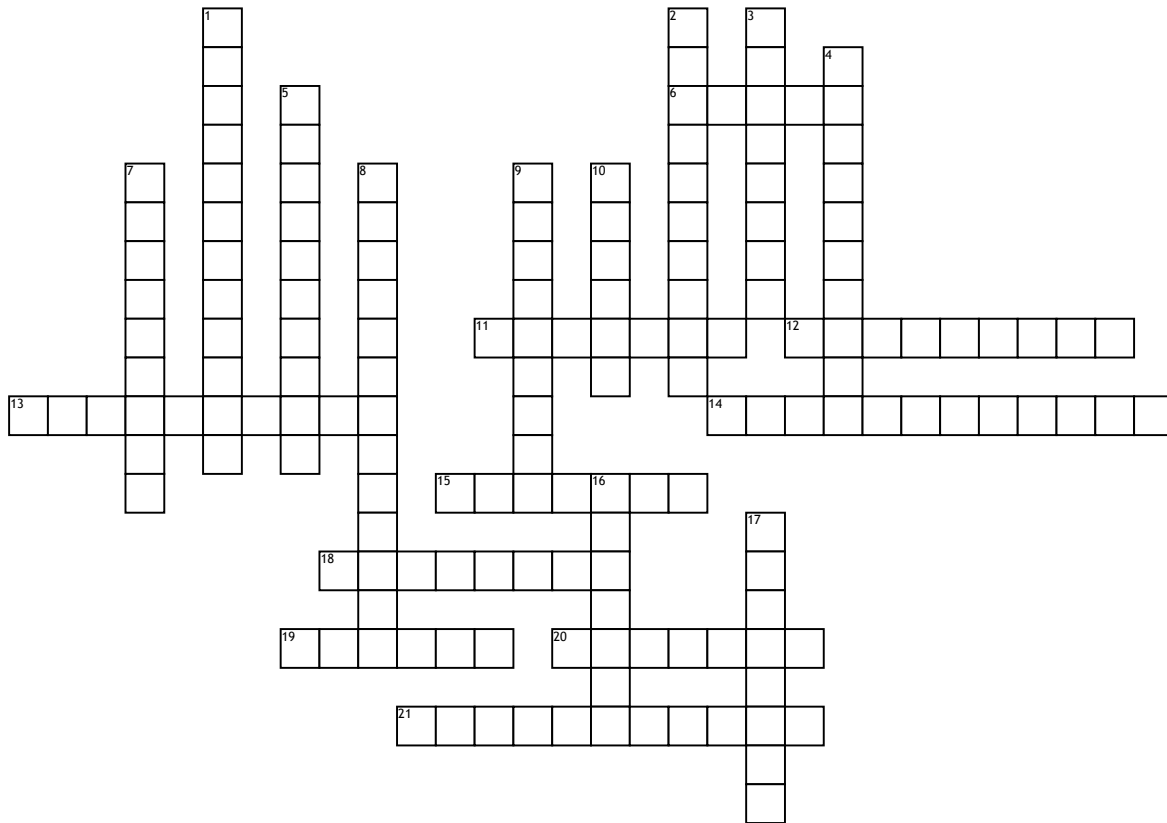


# Business All Risk



**Across**

- 6. An unmanned aerial vehicle used as an aircraft without a human pilot aboard
- 11. .... equipment includes sonar machines, portable x-ray machines and portable heart monitors
- 12. These items can be very expensive and includes gold watches, bracelets etc
- 13. .... damage to tools while being used will not be covered
- 14. .... equipment includes cameras, flashes, lighting screens etc
- 15. Any form of travelling bags, suitcases and briefcases
- 18. programs loaded onto a computer, laptop etc
- 19. .... will cover riot and strikes in Namibia

- 20. This option can be used when the total number of Business All Risk at a particular address are more than 10 and consist of a number of different types
- 21. Money and ..... items are specifically excluded under this cover

- 1. .... plant refers to machinery and equipment that has an electronic function and is linked to a network or server
- 2. ICOW will refer to any ..... costs the insured has to incur to get the business up and running

- 17. .... is allowed even if the items have different makes or values
