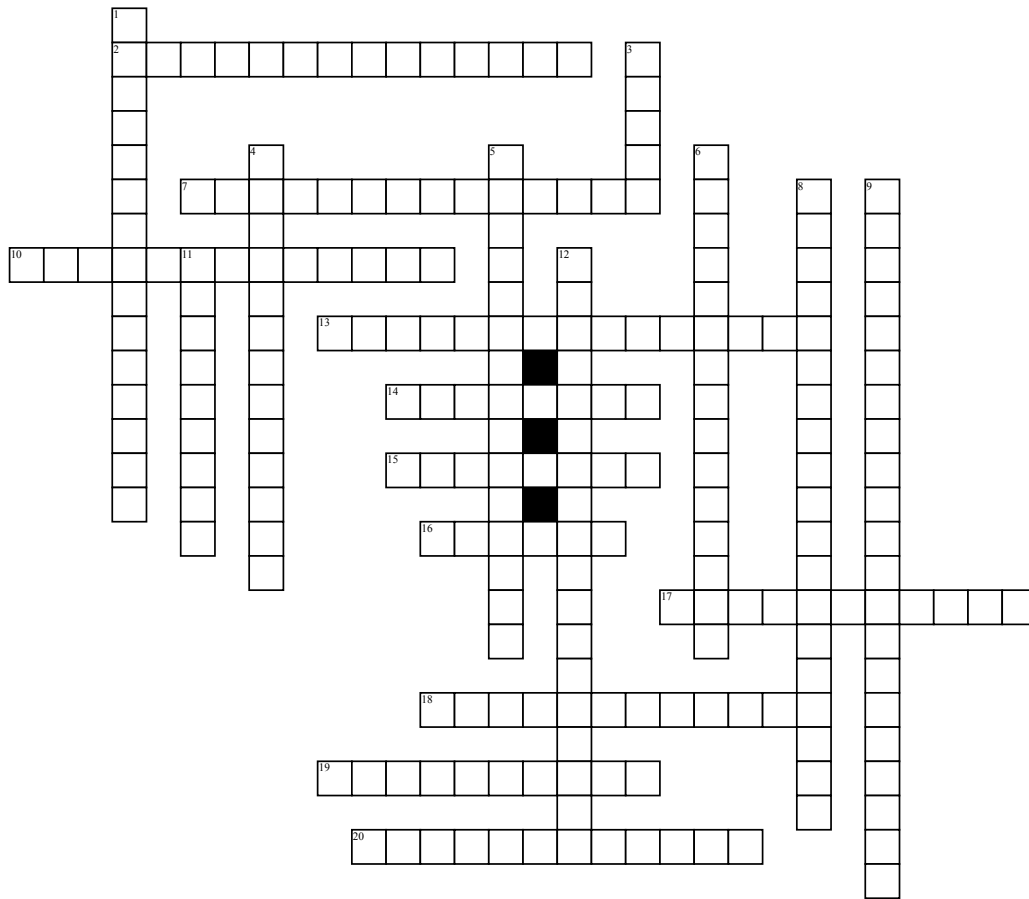


CG1,2,3,4 Crossword Puzzle Assignment
