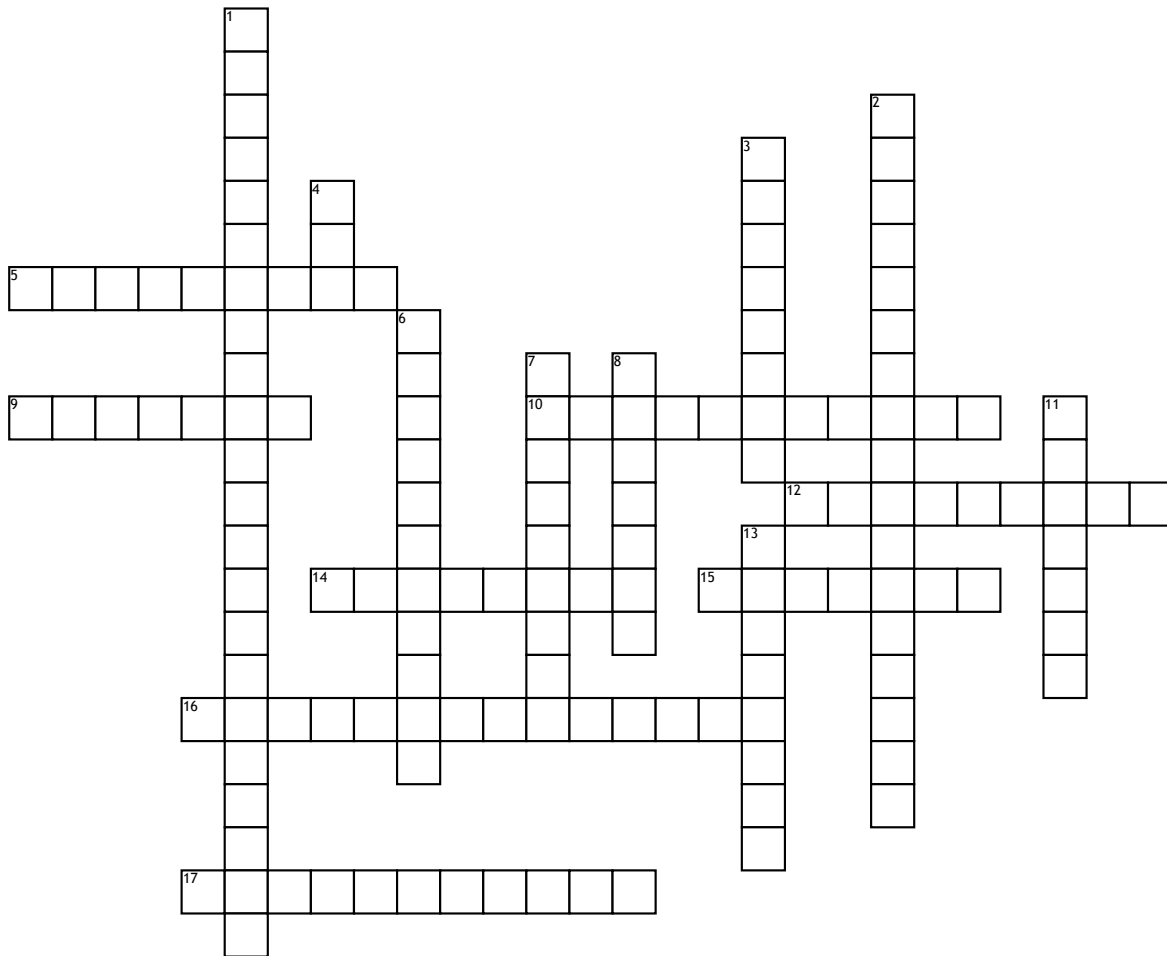


# CNA Class Terms and Definitions



## Across

5. Moving of a body part away from the central axis of the body.

9. Inability to speak or understand speech.

10. When the CNA does not finish an assignment and/or leaves work early without attending to their resident's needs.

12. Difficulty swallowing.

14. Increase of pressure within the eye, resulting in blindness if left untreated.

15. feverish, having a fever

16. An inflammation, sore, or lesion that develops over bony areas and the skin and tissue are injured due to lack of blood flow.

17. Shortening of a joint or muscle.

## Down

1. A sudden drop in the blood pressure when the resident moves from lying to sitting/standing; results in fainting.

2. Irreversible, progressive disease of the brain that typically affects the elderly and is characterized by memory loss, diminished mental ability and confusion. It is the most common cause of dementia.

3. A turning outward.

4. To measure and record all liquids ingested and expelled by the resident.

6. Slow pulse rate. Usually less than 60 bpm.

7. Bad breath.

8. To the side.

11. Failure to provide necessary services to maintain physical/mental health of the resident when such failure presents imminent/probable danger to the resident.

13. Memory and thinking impairment that come on suddenly and is caused by illness or toxic reaction in the body; usually reversible.
