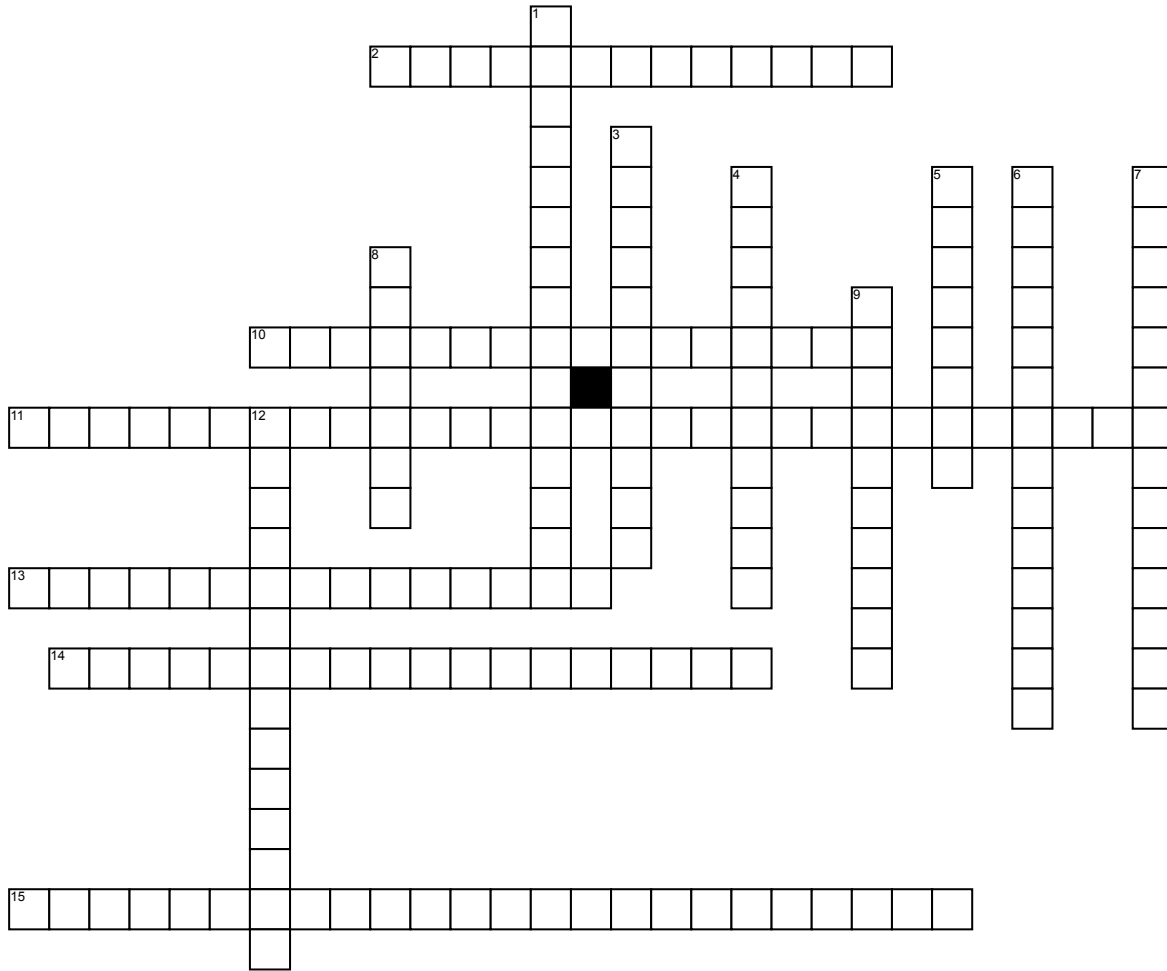


# CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES
