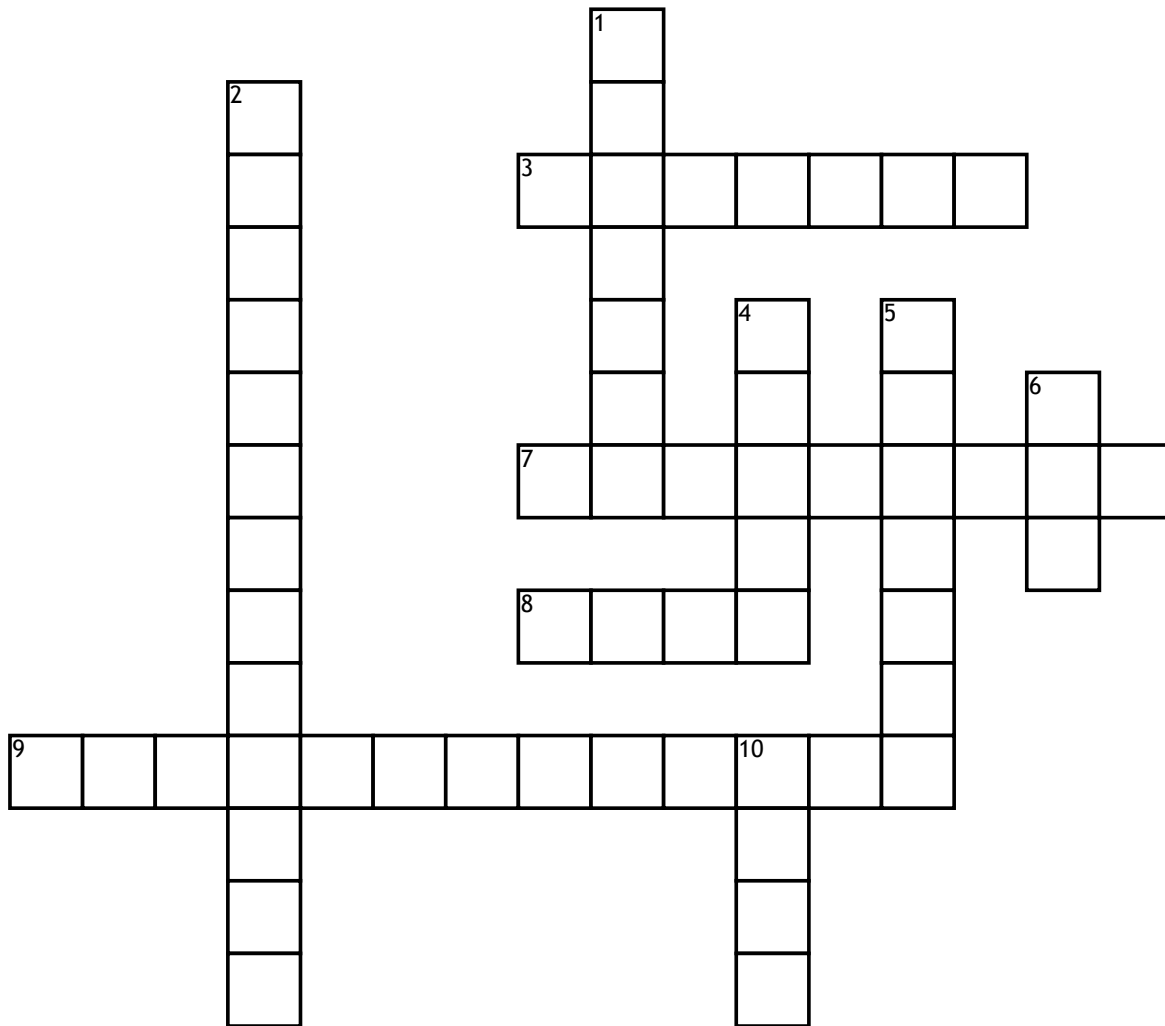


CROSSWORDS - NUCLEAR PLANT
