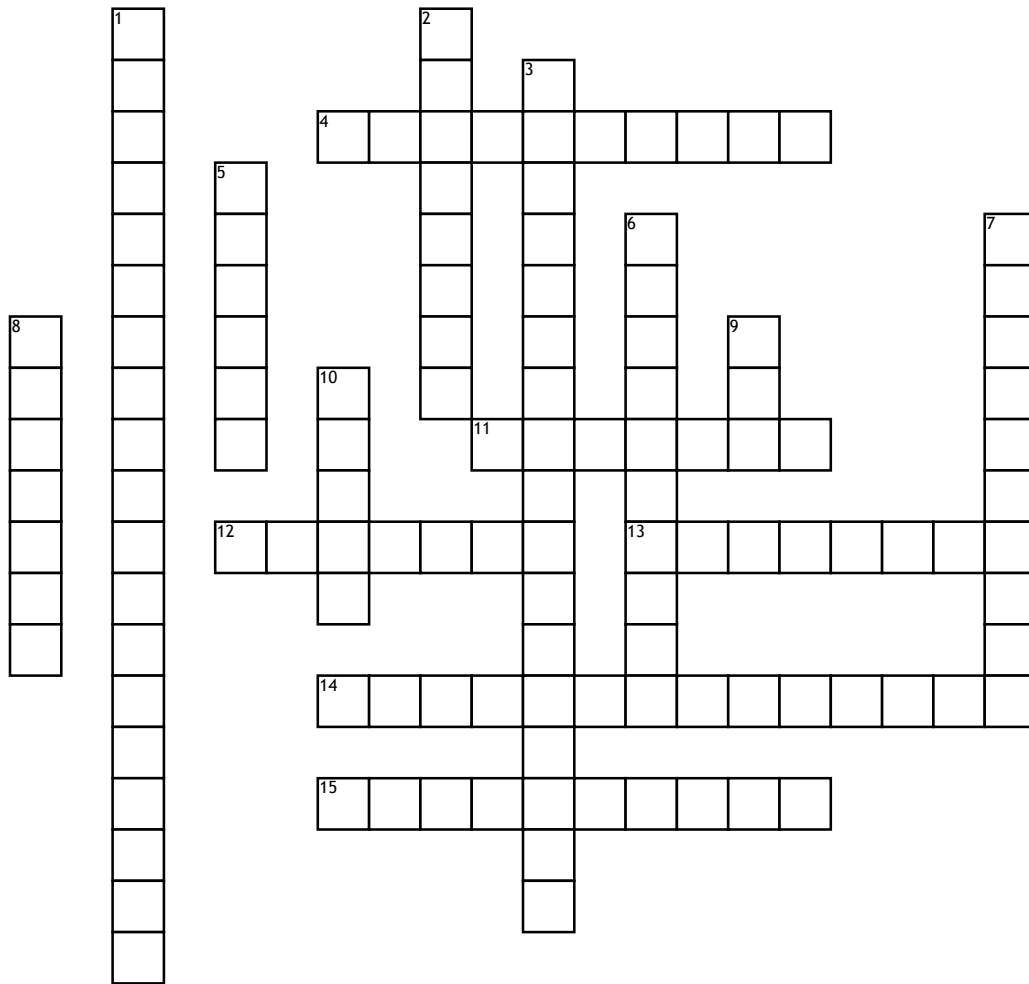


CYBER AWARENESS CROSSWORD
