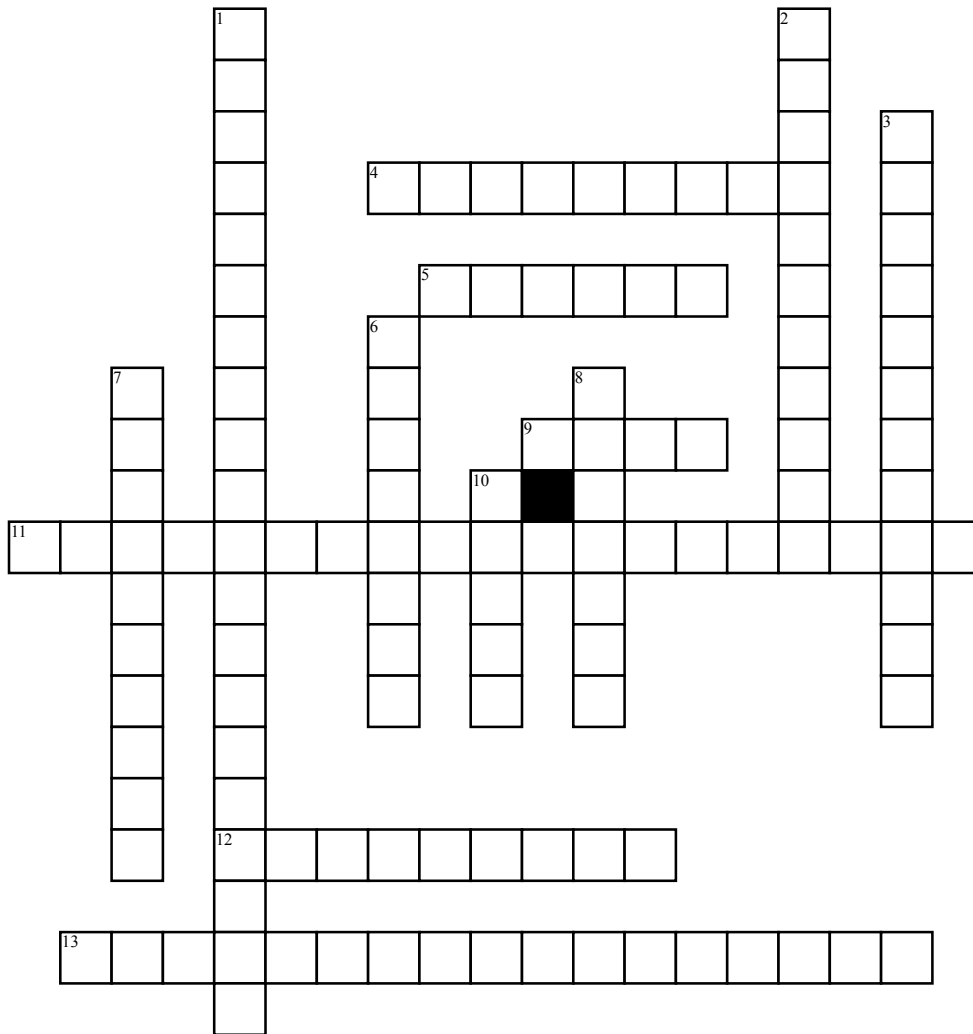


Canadian Terminology

- 4. A location located outside of a city and is considered a countryside and has a low population of people
- 5. Area of a town or city a little away from the main part, there are fewer big buildings and mainly houses
- 9. The location where people decided to build their settlement
- 11. The amount of useable farmland
- 12. The growth of the site depends on the accessibility and availability of natural resources

- 13. The population density measured as the number of people per unit area of land

Down

- 1. The physiological density or real population density is the number of people per unit area of arable land
- 2. A very large populated city or urban complex
- 3. An increase in the population of people living in cities and towns

- 6. This refers to a position on Earth and is defined by two different coordinates longitude and latitude and these can be used to find specific locations
- 7. a very large and densely populated industrial and commercial city
- 8. A small settlement found in rural areas and usually has 500- 2,500 people
- 10. Area surrounding a city that is very developed
