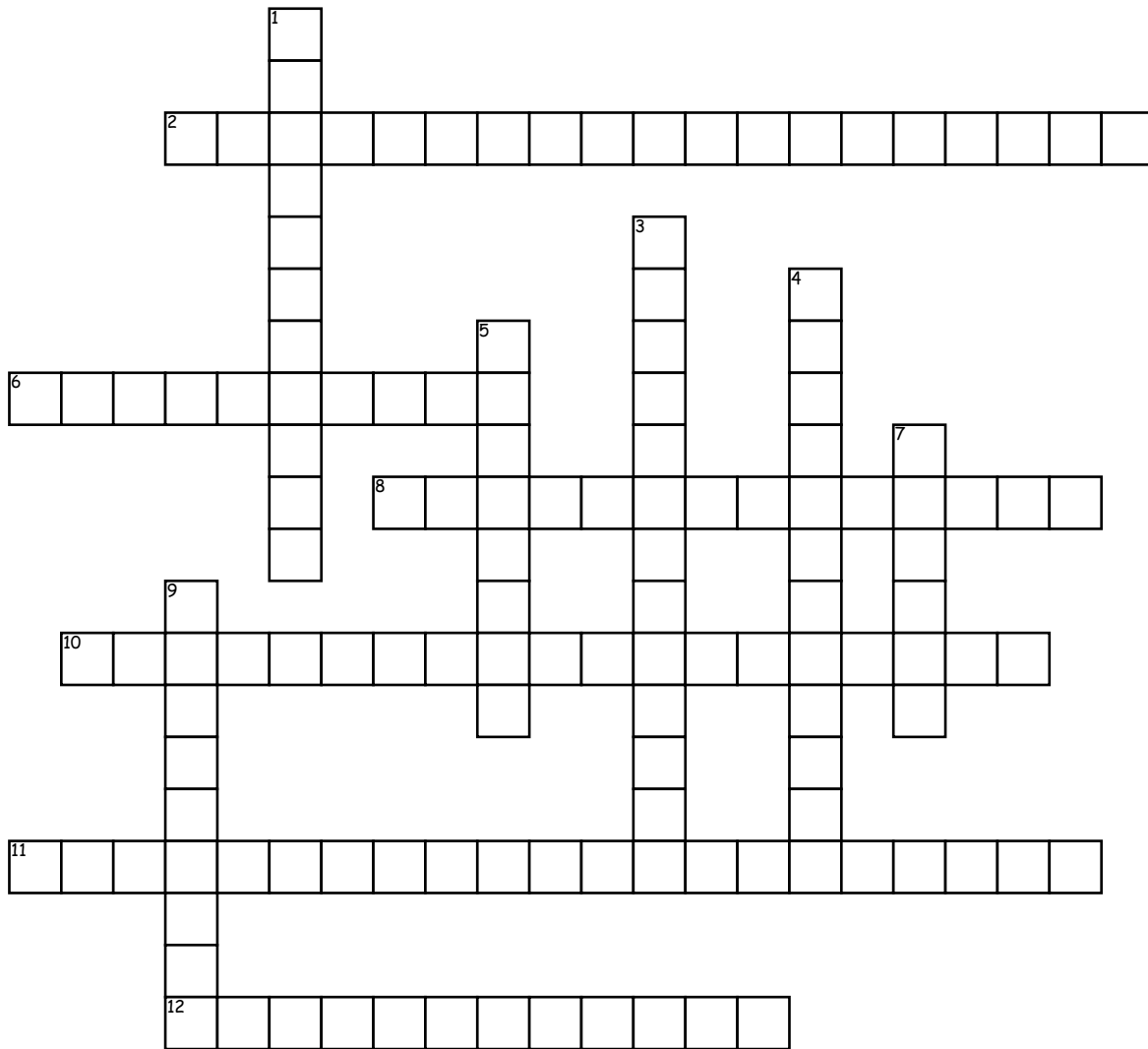


# Careers in Horticulture
