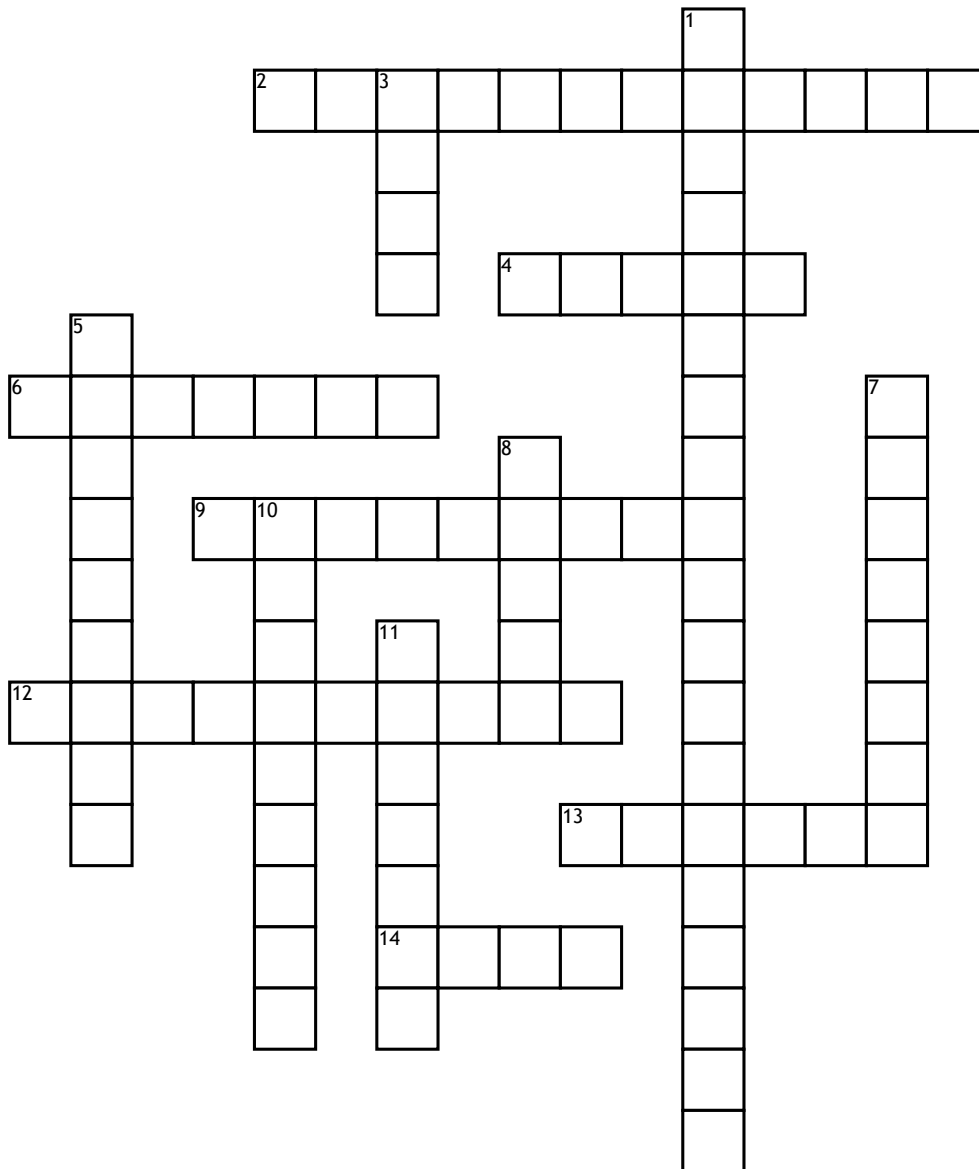


Catholic Church Architecture
