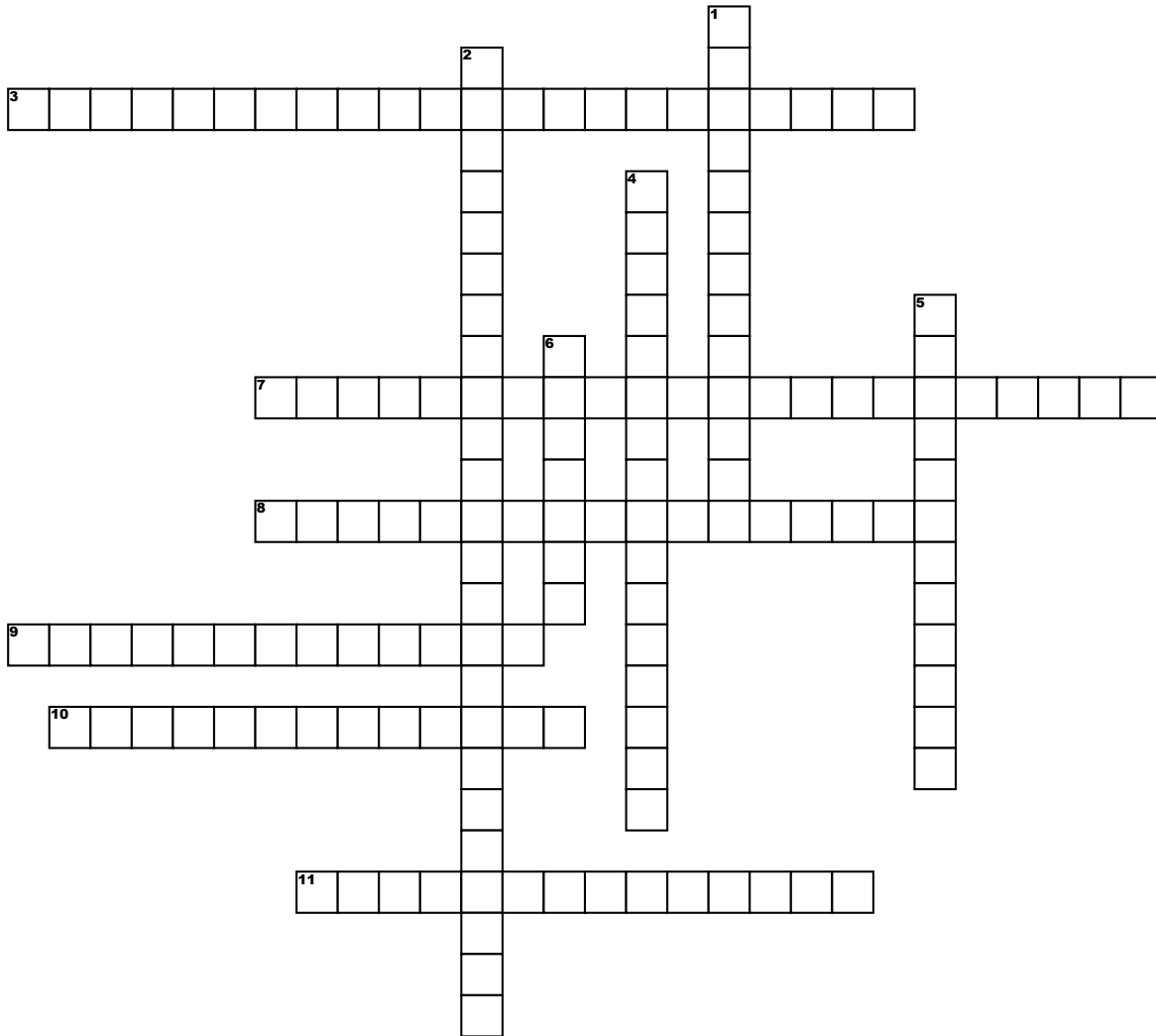


Causes of the Civil War
