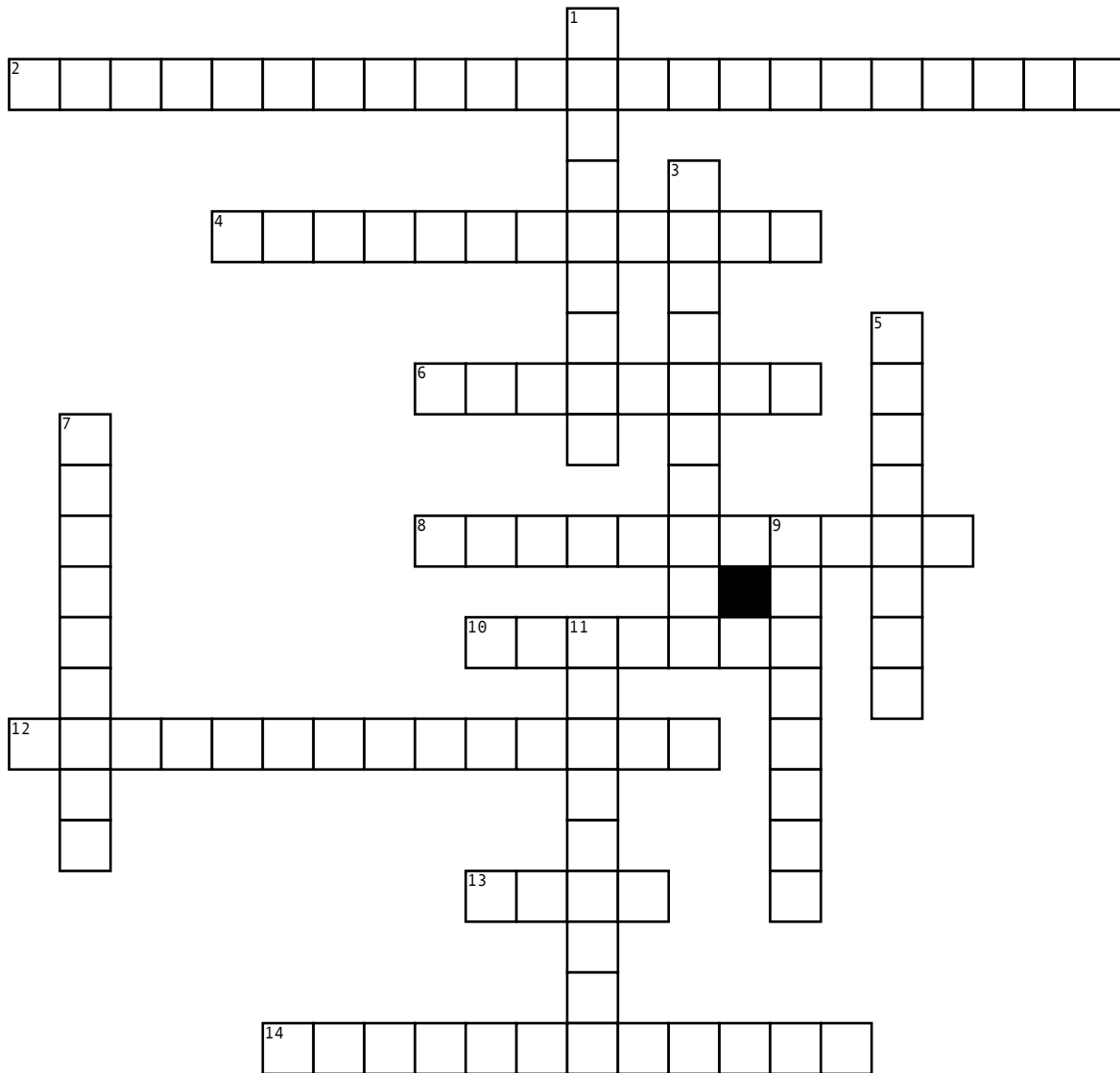


Cell Crossword Puzzle
