 3. Little grains that float inside the cell and are attached to the hard endoplasmic reticulum.
 4. This part of the cell contains our DNA.
 5. Is spotted with Ribosomes; makes new proteins.
 6. Has no ribosomes; moves things around the cell.
 7. Packages things to be transported out of the cell.
 8. Contains digestive enzymes to break down things the cell no longer needs.
 9. Contains large storage sacks used for holding things like food.
 10. Breaks down sugars to make energy.
