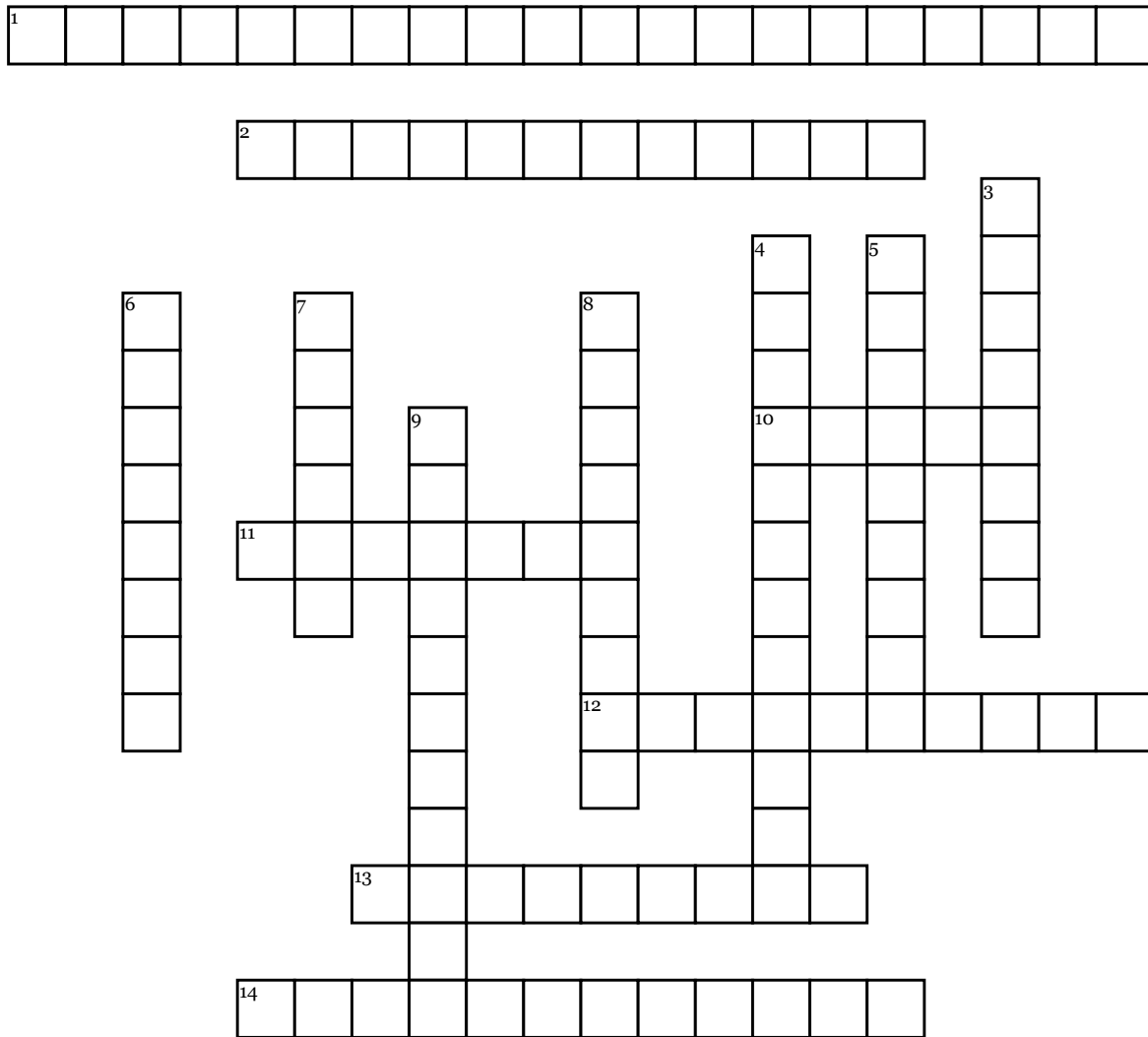


# Cells Unit Crossword
