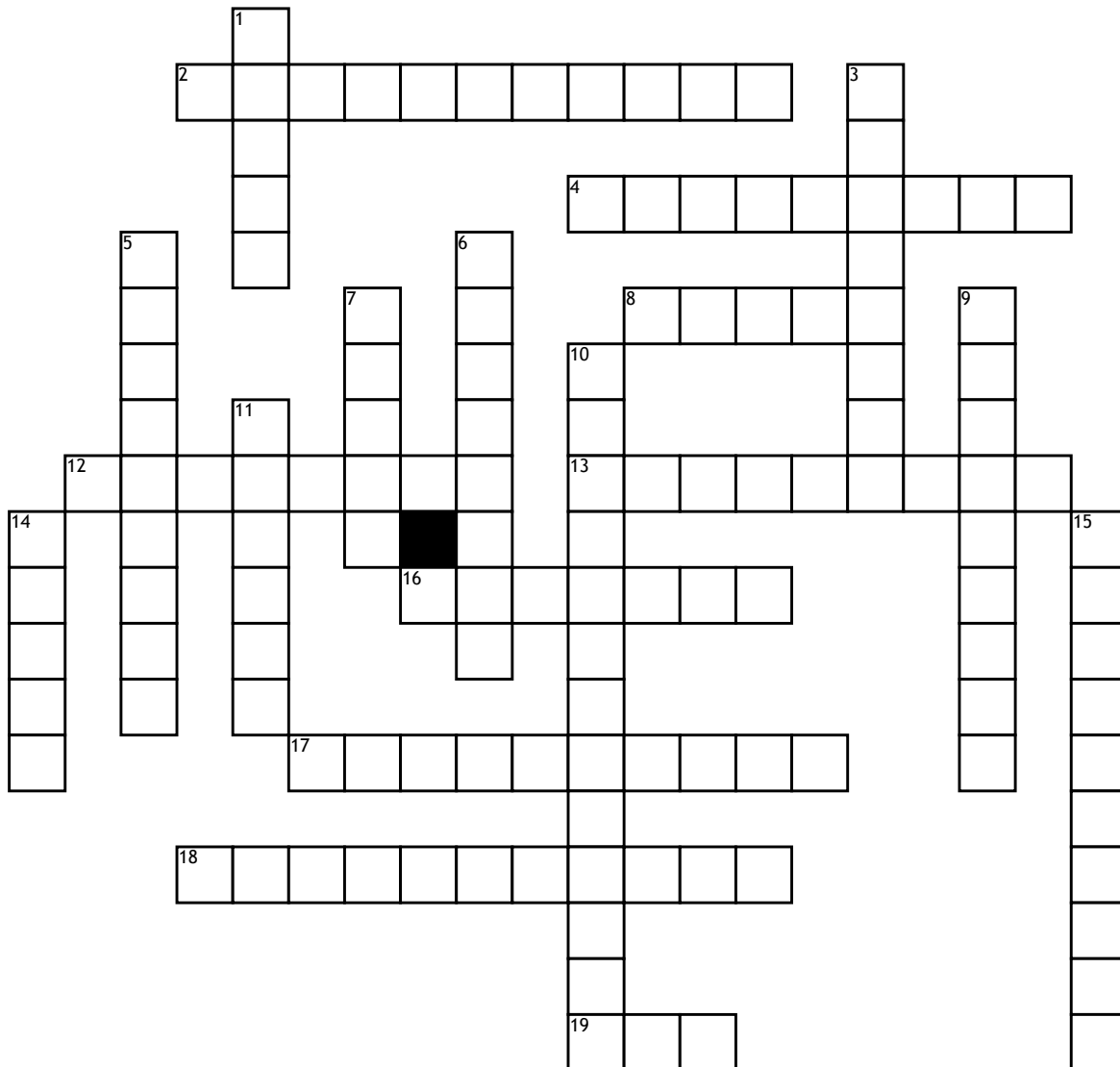


# Cemetery Terms



## Across

2. An above ground stone chamber or monumental chamber for a casket  
 4. Burial of human remains within a grave  
 8. Concrete or steel receptacle that holds a casket  
 12. A grave marker that marks the entire family's plot  
 13. Small burial ground, often associated with a church or religious entity, or on a family farm  
 16. A saying or quote etched upon a grave maker

17. Placing a casket in a mausoleum

18. Urn mausoleum  
 19. An area within the cemetery that is purchased by a family with multiple graves

## Down

1. A row of single graves within a cemetery section  
 3. Large burial ground, most often in an urban setting  
 5. Above-ground structure that houses caskets within spaces called crypts  
 6. A memorial erected over a grave where no body is interred

7. Original purchaser of a cemetery lot or grave

9. Process of placing an urn within a niche  
 10. Permission to be buried in a family plot; requires proof of lineal descent from lot owner  
 11. Placing human remains in an underground vault  
 14. Dedicated space in the ground that receives human remains  
 15. Poured concrete footing to prevent a marker from sinking into the ground
