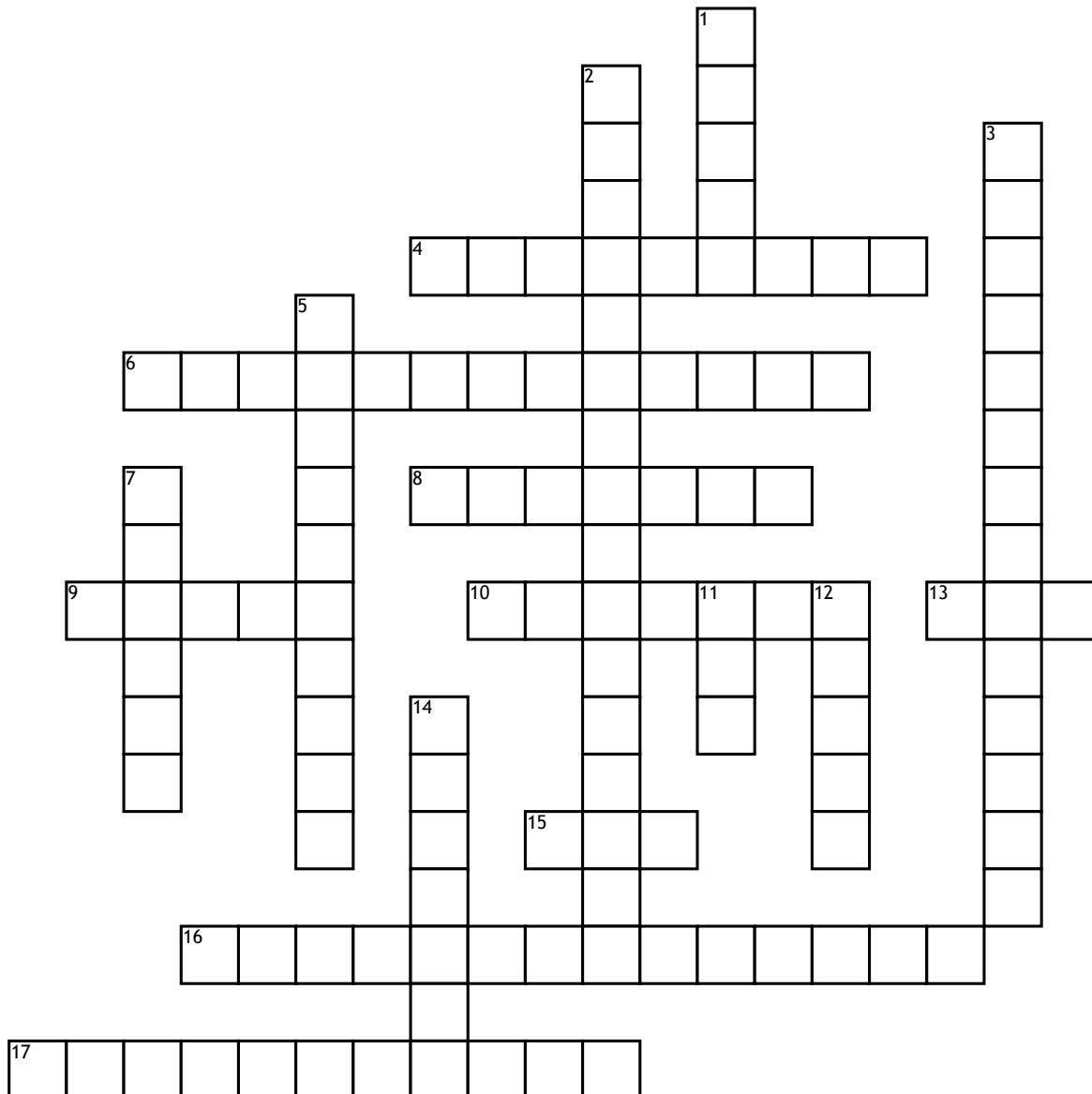


# Central Line Crossword



## Across

4. standard treatment for central line occlusions  
 6. bath that patient must receive every day (unless contraindicated)  
 8. technique used when changing dressings  
 9. clear dressing changes need to be completed every how many days  
 10. technique used during all infusion administration and care  
 13. waste at least this amount of blood (mL) before obtaining blood samples

15. must be removed when drawing blood cultures from central line and replaced with new; must be replaced every 4 days

16. cannot draw blood cultures from central line without this  
 17. can occur during or after removal of a central line as a result of air drawn in along the subcutaneous tract and into the vein

## Down

1. type of occlusion when unable to flush or withdraw blood from catheter  
 2. catheter tip should be in the lower one-third

3. integrity of dressing or otherwise must be changed

5. change this type of tubing every 4 days

7. flush catheter with this amount of fluid (mL) after each blood draw

11. always use this size mL syringe or larger to obtain blood samples

12. every needleless connector needs to be covered with this cap

14. type of occlusion when able to flush catheter but not able to aspirate blood from catheter
