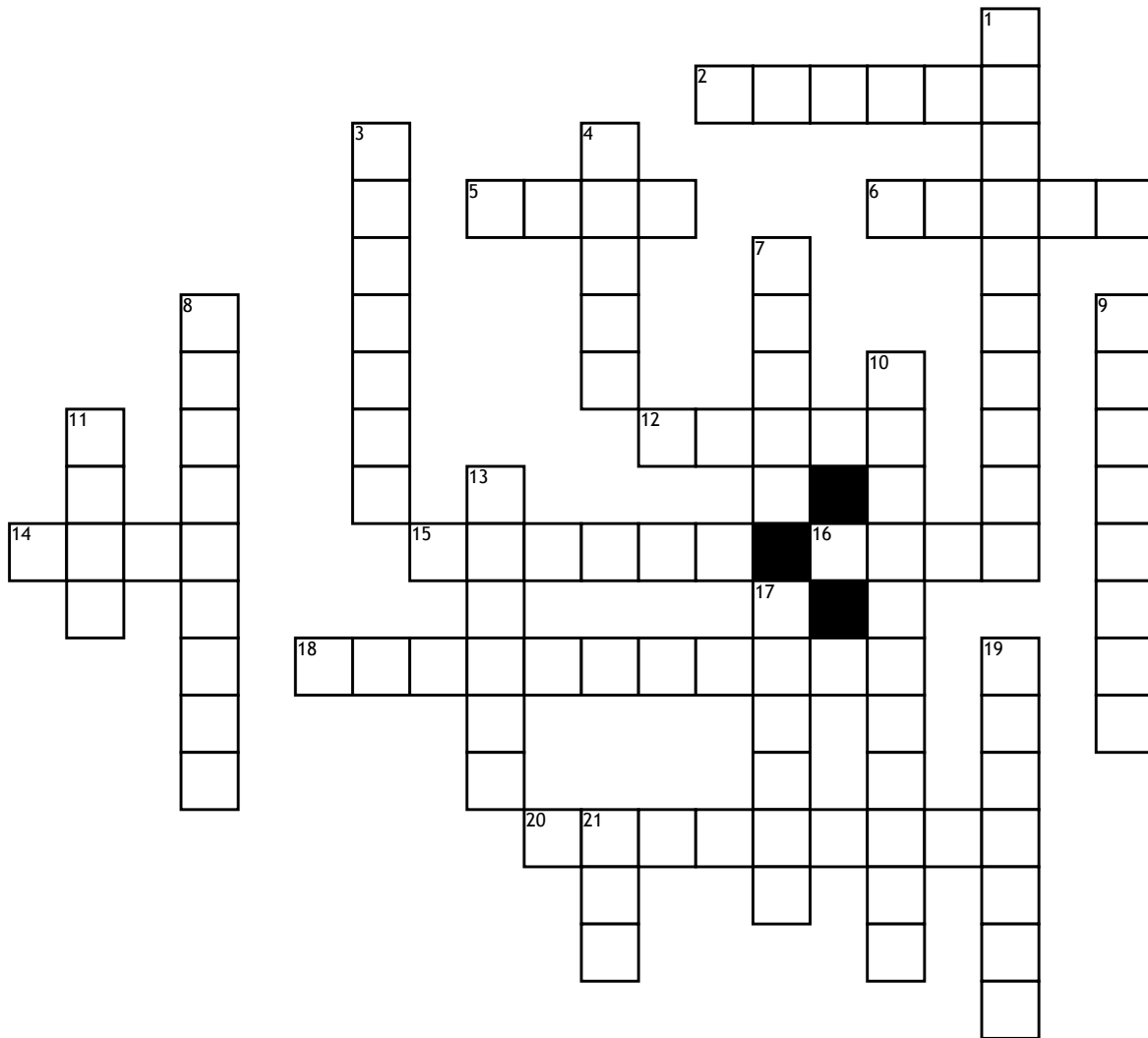


Ceramic Crossword Puzzle

- 3. Another word for wet clay
- 4. The paint used for clay that turns into a glass-like surface
- 7. Making cross-hatches in the clay before connecting two pieces together
- 8. What we need to wipe our bisque pieces with before glazing

- 9. The type of texture when we add clay to our piece
- 10. Clay that is a couple days dry but still workable; just a little firmer than wet clay
- 11. What we need to put in an enclosed piece of clay so it can "breathe"
- 13. The part of the piece we never glaze
- 17. What we are doing to clay when we put it in the kiln to "bake"
- 19. Clay that is air-dried out and at its most fragile state
- 21. Silver metal tool we use to smooth or scrape our clay
