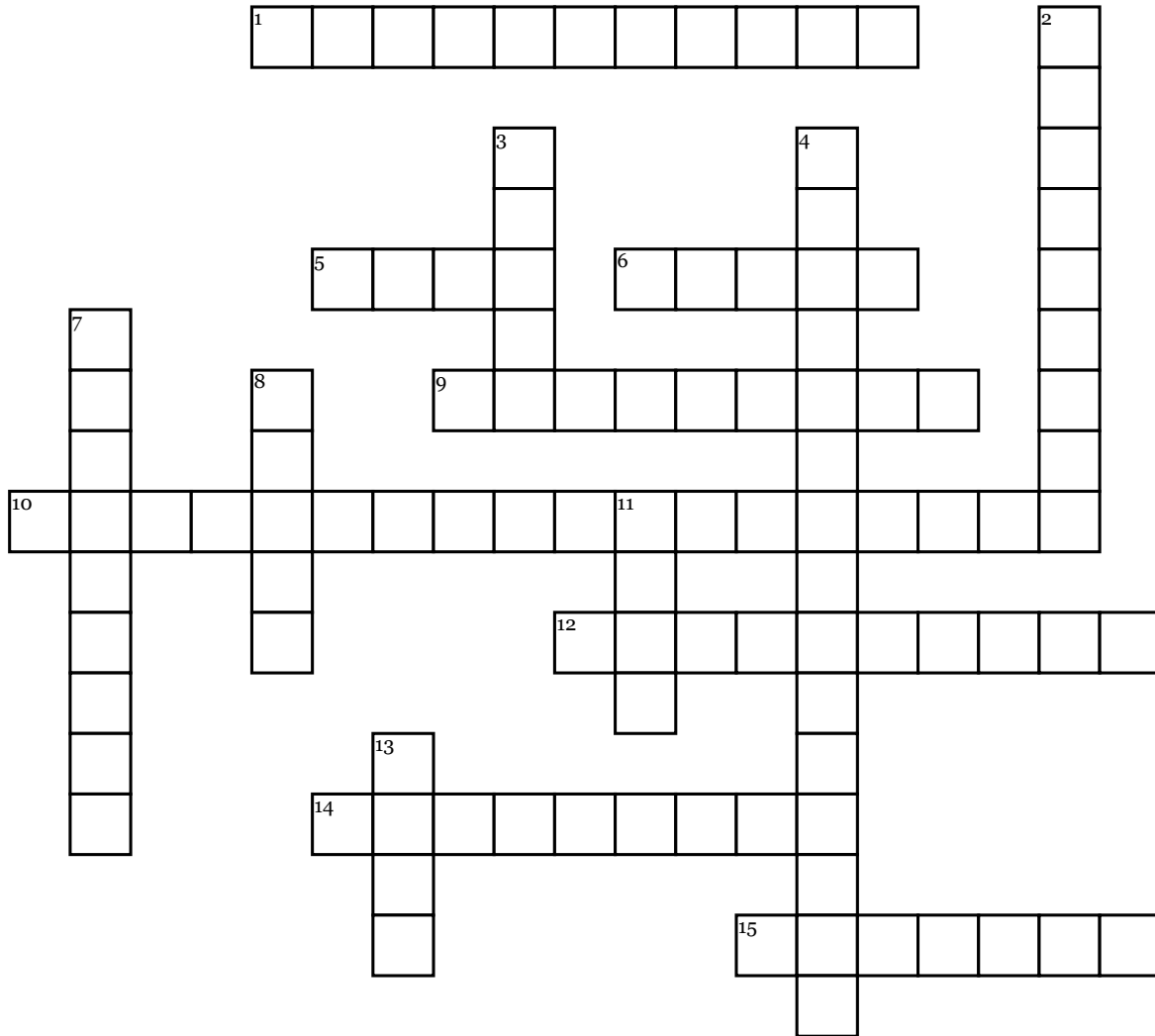


# Ceramic Terms
