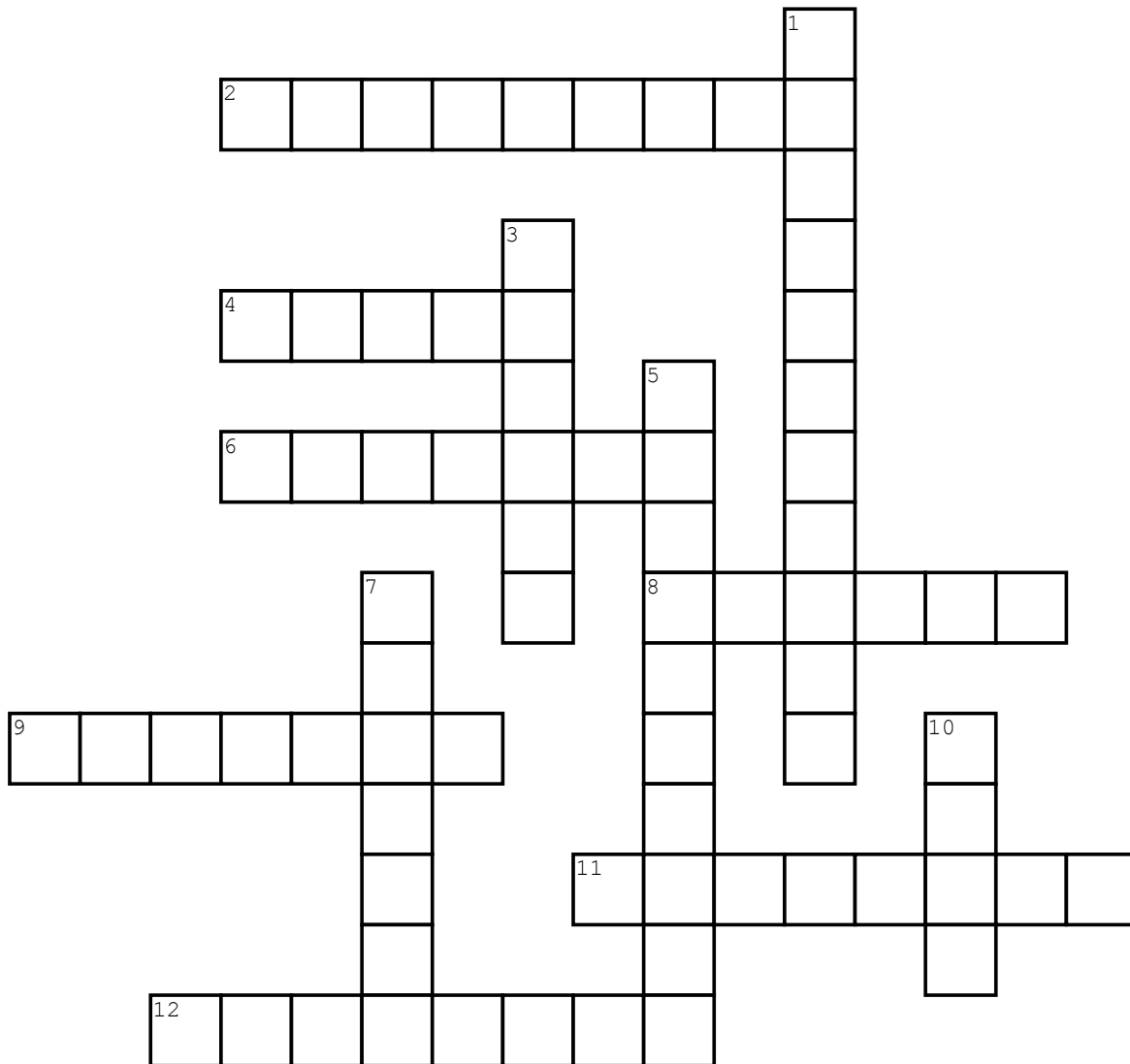


# Ceramic Terms

2. Unfired clay pieces

4. A coating that has been matured to the glassy state on a formed ceramic article, or the material or mixture from which the coating is made.

6. A machine for consolidating plastic clay or body into a firm column

8. Pieces of broken pottery

9. Process of incising shallow grooves into surface of wet or leatherhard clay in cross-hatch pattern before applying slurry and joining pieces.

11. A method of forming clay, which is well described by its name

12. A clay designed for a special purpose.

1. The condition of a clay or clay body when it has been partially dried to the point where all shrinkage has been completed

3. Added pieces of clay on to another so it sticks out from surface

5. is the quality of clay that allows it to be manipulated and still maintain its shape without cracking

7. The final stage of greenware dried to a completely dry state and ready to be fired. In this stage, the clay is very fragile, non-plastic and porous.

10. is the clay body mixed with water
