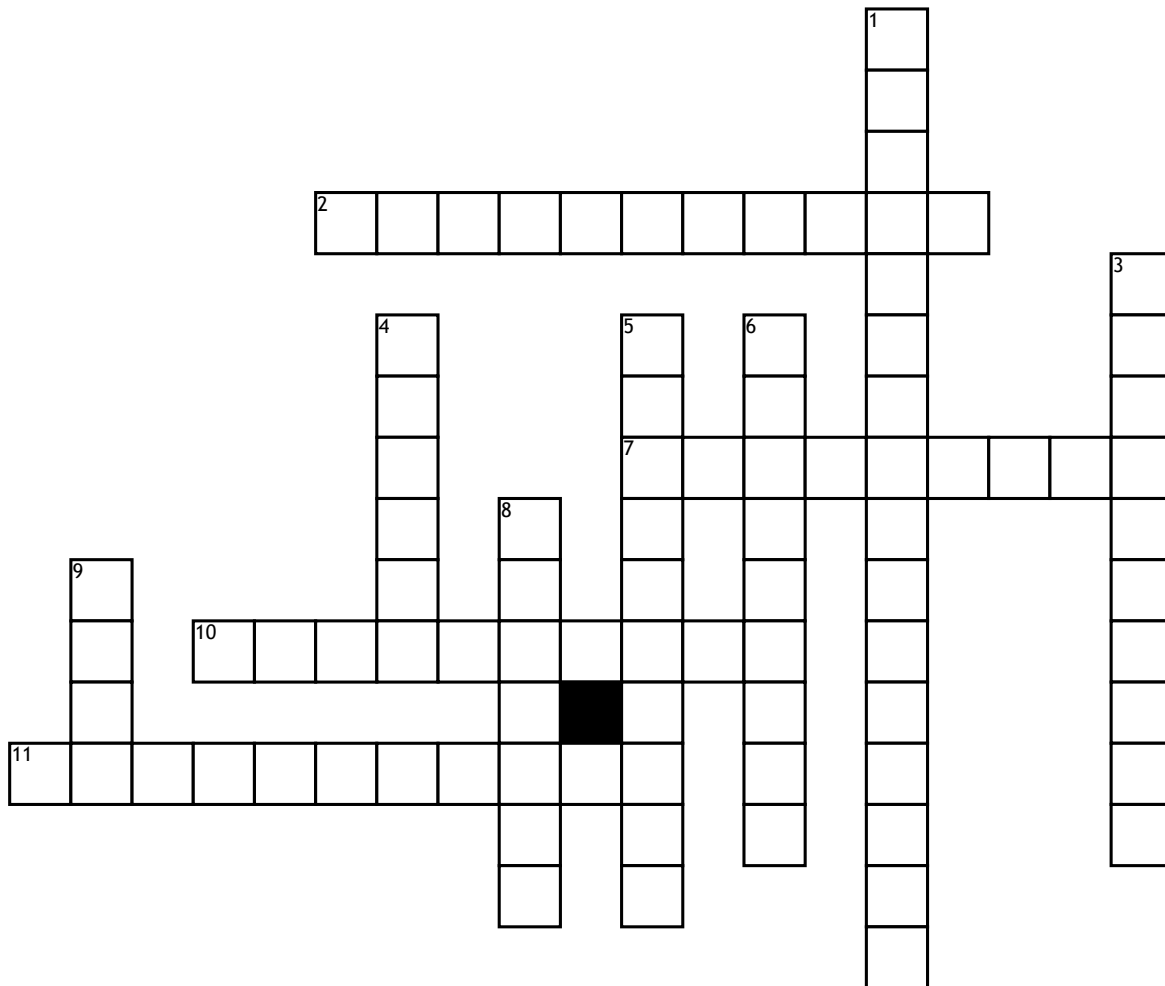


# Ch. 15- The Knee



## Across

2. Pertaining to the nervous intervention of the muscles
7. Muscle group responsible for taking leg away from the midline
10. Muscles that counteract the action of the agonist
11. Muscle insertion point on the proximal medial tibia, also home to a bursa commonly inflamed

## Down

1. Disease characterized by the epiphyseal inflammation of the tibial tubercle

3. Muscle group of the posterior thigh
4. The bicep femoris attaches on this bone
5. 4 muscles of the anterior thigh: rectus femoris, vastus medialis, vastus intermedius, vastus lateralis
6. Muscle group responsible for bringing muscles back to the midline
8. Muscles in a state of contraction as related to opposing muscles
9. Articulation (bicondylar) formed by the medial and lateral femoral condyles and the medial and lateral tibial condyles
