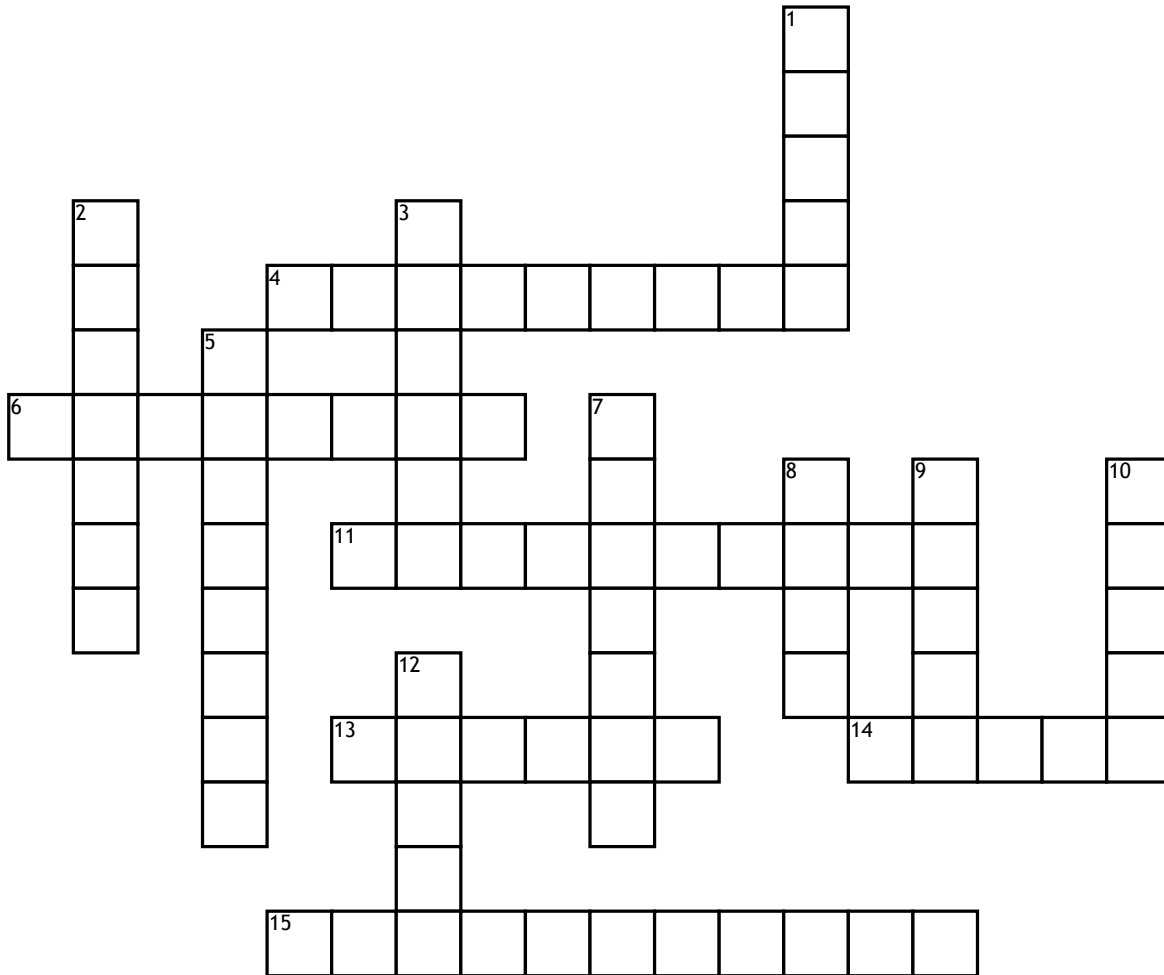


Chalice in Schools
