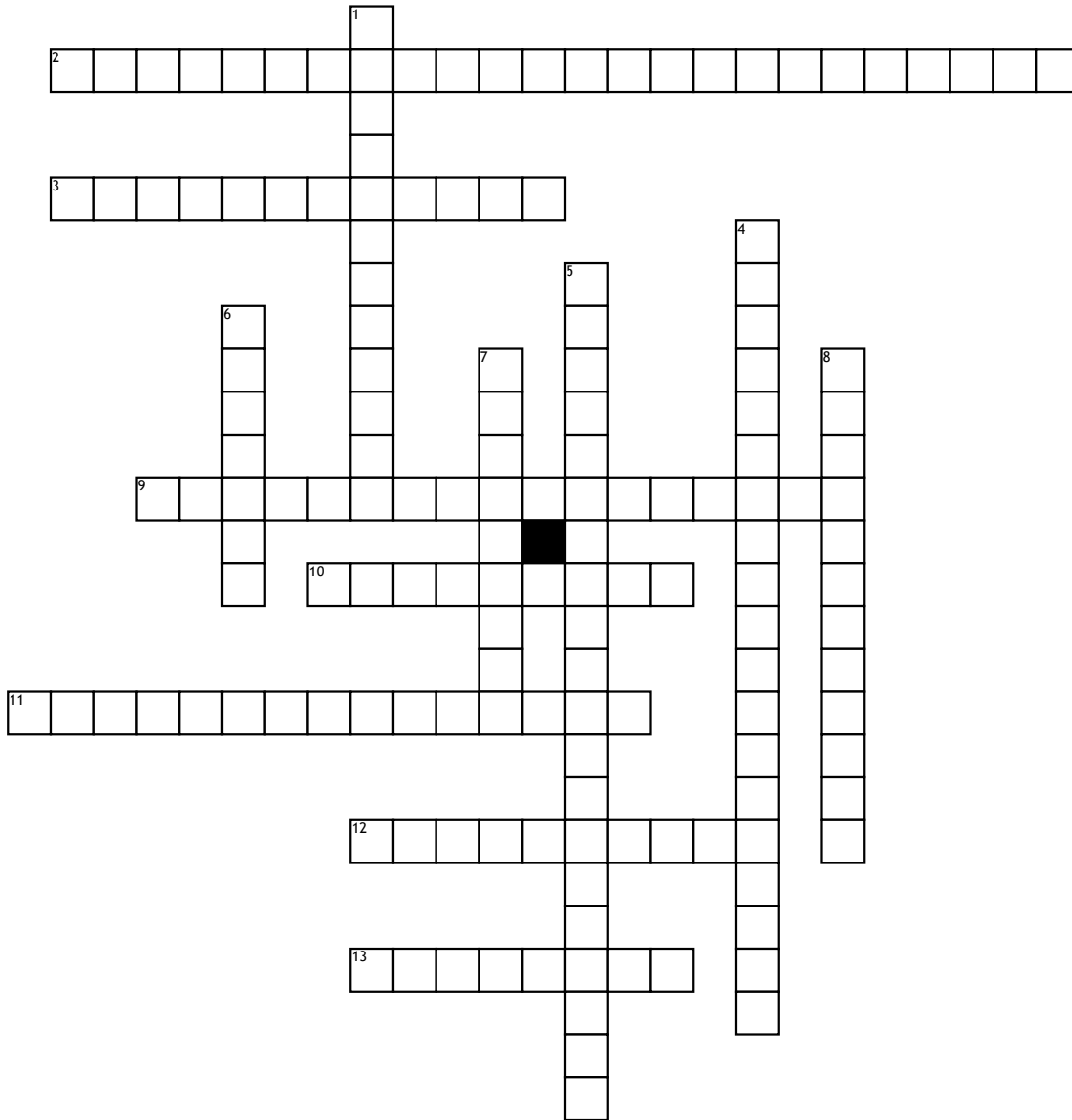


# Chapter 11: Civil War

- 2. The Emancipation Proclamation, or Proclamation 95, was a presidential proclamation and executive order issued by U.S. President Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863.
- 3. The Anaconda Plan is the name applied to a U.S. Union Army outline strategy for suppressing the Confederacy at the beginning of the American Civil War
- 9. The Gettysburg Address is a speech by U.S. President Abraham Lincoln, and one of the best-known speeches in American history
- 10. An income tax is a tax imposed on individuals or entities (taxpayers) that varies with respective income or profits

- 11. The National Bank Act of 1863 was designed to create a national banking system, float federal war loans, and establish a national currency. Congress passed the act to help resolve the financial crisis that emerged during the early days of the American Civil War
- 12. A northern democrat who advocated making peace with the confederacy during the civil war
- 13. The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) is a private humanitarian institution founded in 1863 in Geneva, Switzerland, in particular by Henry Dunant and Gustave Moynier
