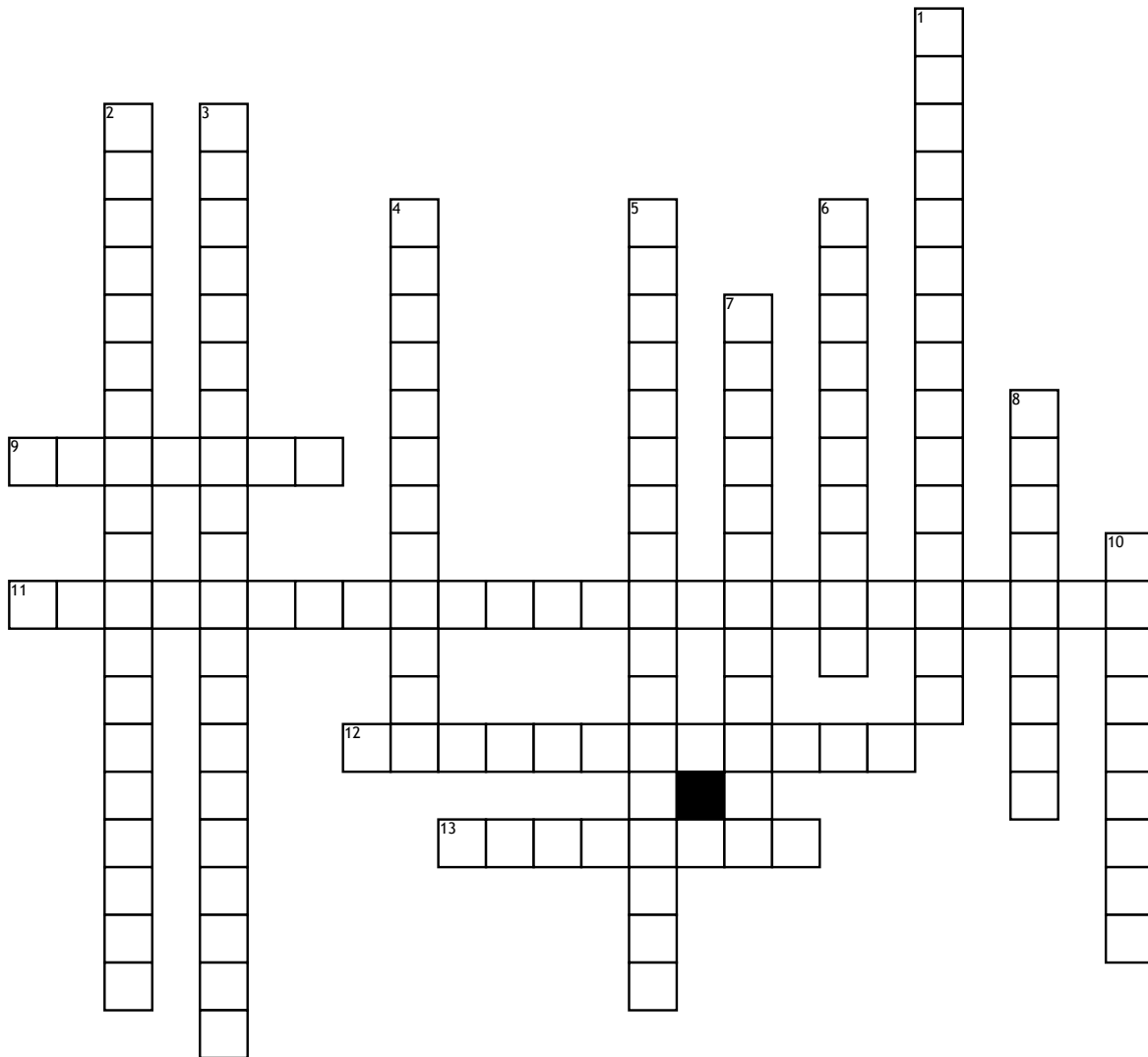


Chapter 11: The Civil War

- 13. An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disaster. Clara Barton founded the American branch in 1881

- 1. Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safer for investors. It's provisions included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspections of banks
- 2. An amendment to the U.S. Constitution, adopted in 1865, that abolished slavery and involuntary servitude
- 3. Town near Appomattox, Virginia, where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9, 1865, thus ending the civil war
- 4. The drafting of citizens for military service

- 5. A famous speech delivered by Abraham Lincoln in November 1863, at the dedication of national cemetery on the site of the Battle of Gettysburg
- 6. A Northern Democrat who advocated making peace with the confederacy during the civil war
- 7. A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court so that the court can determine whether the prisoner is being held legally
- 8. A ironclad ship used by the south in the civil war
- 10. A tax on earning
