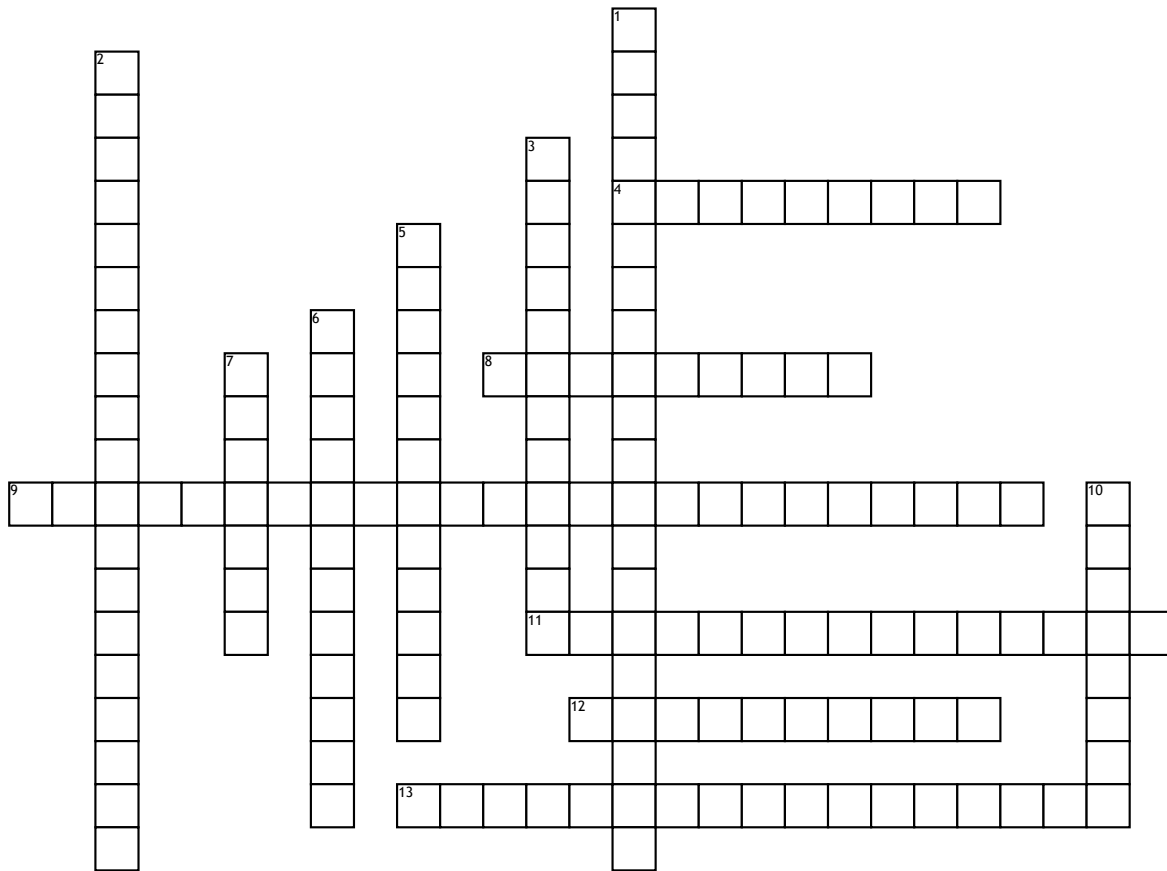


Chapter 11 The Civil War

- 1. Town near Appomattox, Virginia where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9, 1865. Thus ending the civil war
- 2. An amendment to the U.S. constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude
- 3. A three part strategy by which the union proposed to defeat the confederacy
- 5. The drafting of citizens into military service

- 6. A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court so the court can determine whether the prisoner is being held legally
- 7. Ironclad ship used by the north in the civil war
- 10. An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disasters. Clara Barton founded the American branch in 1881
