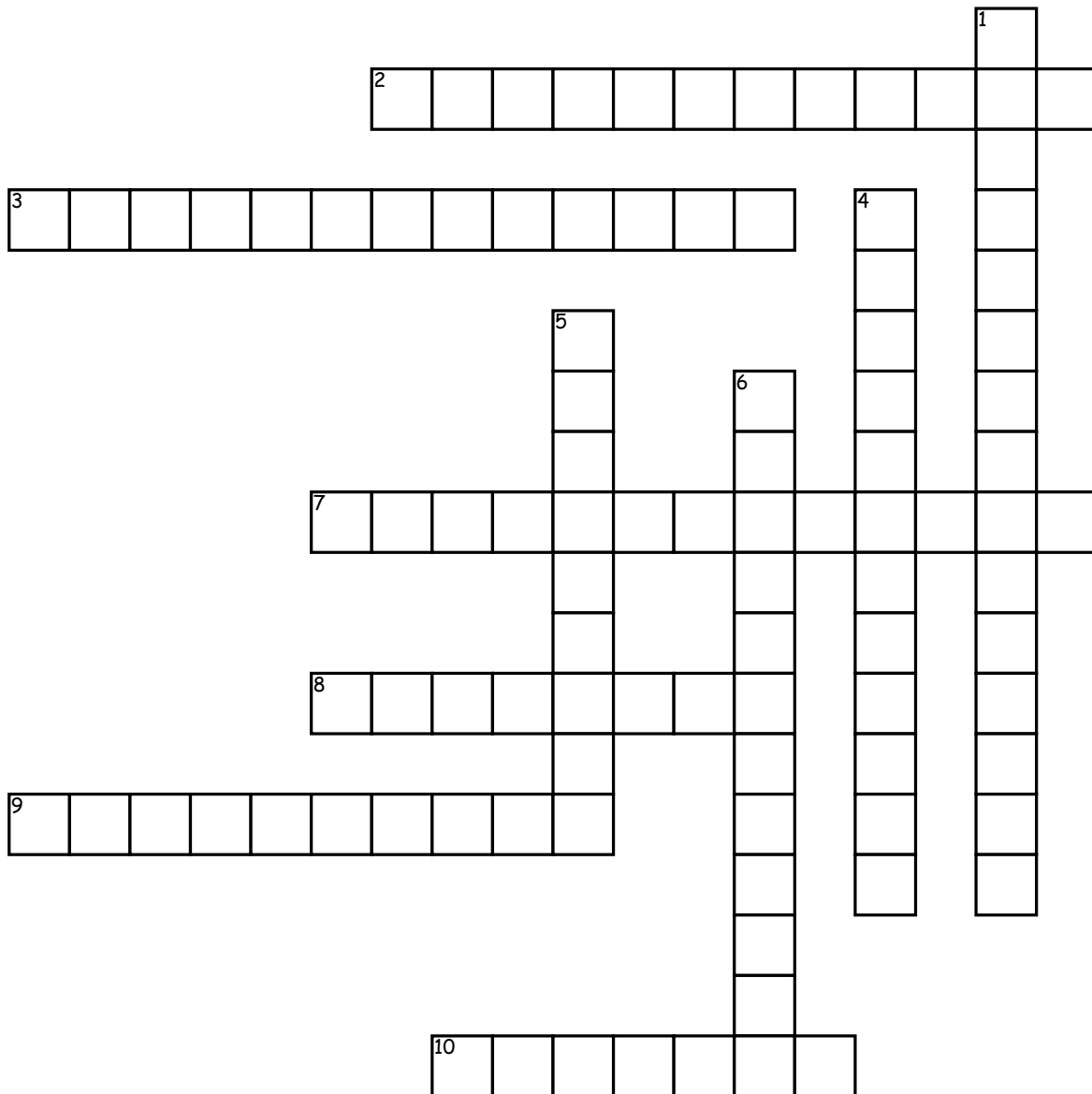


# Chapter 13 Crossword Puzzle
